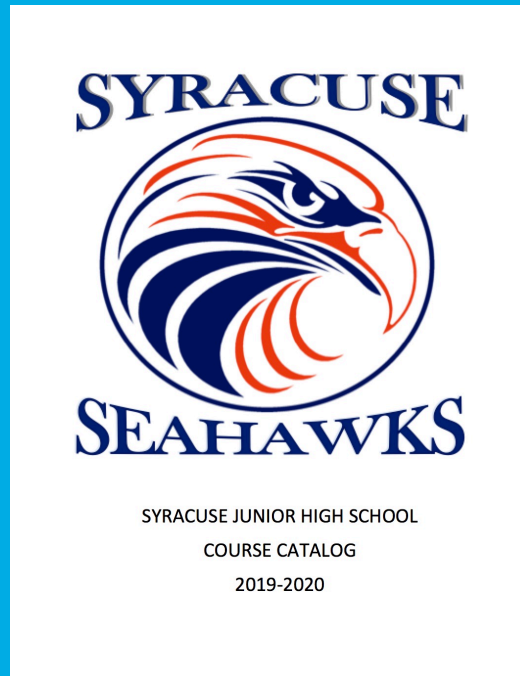

# A FEW THINGS:

- World Languages:
  - DO NOT select Foreign Language Survey as an elective if you are enrolling in any World Language class
- Keyboarding:
  - Take this class if you type less than 35 wpm (words per minute), it is a prerequisite to type 35 wpm to take the required 8<sup>th</sup> grade Digital Literacy class.
- Art
  - Consider taking Art Foundations I, if you plan to continue in visual arts in 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade. This class is a prerequisite for any other visual arts class.

# A FEW MORE THINGS

- Some students might be a good candidate for the following:
  - Study Skills & Study Hall have the same course number(#2400), so please select the specific course that you are interested in (Descriptions below)
    - Study Skills: Students needing some organization, note-taking skills, etc.
    - Study Skills Hall: Students who just need more time to work on class/homework
- NAL (National Academic League) is a new course offering for students this year. This trivia-based curriculum prepares students to compete as a member of the NAL team.
- Dance requires in-class performances every 2-3 weeks. TEAM SPORTS is a misleading name.



# MATH ACCELERATION

Seventh grade students who want to accelerate their mathematics course have two ways to qualify for the 7<sup>th</sup> /8<sup>th</sup> grade Accelerated (2-in-1) math class. EVERYONE who is placed into the accelerated class MUST qualify based on one of the following two ways.

1. Students scoring above 440 on their 5<sup>th</sup> grade SAGE test are pre-identified as potential students.
    - Subject to change due to:
      - Proficiency results on 6<sup>th</sup> grade end of level test
  2. Students may also pre-identify by taking the quantitative portion of the CogAT test and score 90 or above.
    - CogAT testing is performed at the District from 4-5 pm on February 28, March 21, or April 25.
    - You must call Margo Hammond at (801)402-5251 to set up a time to test.
    - The District will then provide us a list of qualifying students to place into the 2-in-1 Accelerated math class.
- There are two options if you are not interested in the accelerated math:
    - 7<sup>th</sup> grade math honors or regular
    - You can sign up for the 7<sup>th</sup> grade math over the summer, and, once successful, we will make the change to 8<sup>th</sup> grade math honors for next year (information in March).
