ENROLLMENT FOR 2018-19

Transitional Kindergarten, Kindergarten and New Students Entering Grades 1-5

Elementary schools will conduct ENROLLMENT beginning on MONDAY, FEBRUARY 26, for students who are entering TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN, KINDERGARTEN and students in GRADES 1-5 who are new to the Tustin Unified School District. Currently enrolled students do not need to register.

- 1. Enrollment begins at your school of residence on Monday, February 26, 2018.
- 2. A child who is 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2018, may register for kindergarten for the 2018-19 school year.
- 3. Legal proof of the child's birth date must be presented at the time of enrollment. Legal proof may be a birth certificate or passport.
- 4. Proof of residency must be provided in two forms: (1) mortgage statement, rental contract, lease agreement, escrow paper, or grant deed; (2) gas, electric, or water bill; and photo ID of parent or guardian.
- 5. California law requires certain immunizations for children under 18 years of age to enter or transfer into public elementary and secondary schools (grades K-12). Parents must provide health immunization records at the time of enrollment.

Polio	4 doses at any age, but 3 doses meet requirements for ages 4-6 years if at least one was
	given on or after the 4 th birthday; 3 doses meet requirement for ages 7-17 years if at least one
	was given on or after the 2 nd birthday.
Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis	Age 6 years and under: DTP, DTaP or any combination of DTP or DTaP with DT (diphtheria and tetanus) 5 doses at any age, but 4 doses meet requirements for ages 4-6 years if at least one was on or after the 4 th birthday.
	Age 7 years and older: Tdap, Td, or DTP, DTaP or any combination of these 4 doses at any age, but 3 doses meet requirements for ages 7-17 years if at least one was on or after the 2 nd birthday. If last dose was given before the 2 nd birthday, one more (Tdap) dose is required.
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	2 doses both on or after 1 st birthday.
Hepatitis B	3 doses at any age.
Varicella	1 dose or Physician - documented varicella (chickenpox) disease history.

- 6. Students may enroll but may not begin school unless immunizations are current.
- 7. When your child is enrolled in first grade, an appropriate health/physical examination is required. This is to be completed no earlier than 18 months prior to first grade entry, or no later than 90 days after the first day of school. If the school does not receive the student's health/physical examination results on the state form PM171A on the 90th day after school begins, the student will be excluded from attending school.
- 8. For all students entering Transitional Kindergarten or Kindergarten, and first graders not previously enrolled in kindergarten, California law requires proof of an oral health assessment by a licensed dentist or other licensed or registered dental health professional that was performed no earlier than 12 months prior to the date of initial enrollment.

You are encouraged to take advantage of enrollment. Enrollment will help the District plan classes and staffing for the 2018-19 school year. If you have questions regarding enrollment, please contact your school office.
