

# MHS COUNTDOWN INFORMATION for SENIORS!

### COLLEGE

**Texas public schools** (colleges, universities, technical institutes) require that you take the THEA (Texas Higher Education Assessment) test unless you meet the current exemption criteria.

### FEES

Your final transcript will be held if you have any outstanding debts (library fines, lost textbooks, equipment, lab, gym or other fees)

### TRANSCRIPTS

The final transcript card that you receive in your Senior Advisory class in April will need to be completed and returned to the registrar. This will determine what school will receive your final grades and verification of graduation. If your college decision changes after that, notify the registrar immediately.

### IMPORTANT DATES - ALL DATES SUBJECT TO CHANGE

- February 11 - March 1** AP Test Registration online – see MHS website
- February 20** Balfour picking up payments for cap/gown orders in cafeteria during both lunches  
If you miss this date you must order online (www.balfour.com) or at 1221 Lumpkin, Suite A  
Orders after March 3 will be charge a late fee
- February 28** Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) testing – See your counselor if interested.
- March 25, 27, 28** TSI testing in the MPR – your counselor will notify you if you need to take this test
- March 25-April 4** **Prom tickets** are FREE to MHS Seniors. **ALL Seniors must complete and sign a Code of Behavior form online by April 5 to attend prom (check SBISD email). All guests that are not MHS Seniors must purchase a ticket for \$20 and guests must have a signed behavior form on file. Tickets and forms for guests are available in G-201.**
- April 5** **Code of Behavior for Graduation & Prom form** must be completed online. See school e-mail for link.
- April 11** **Complete final transcript card in Advisory.**
- April 13** **Senior Prom-** Red Oak Ballroom – **8:00 pm – 12:00 am** – No entry after 9:30 – no readmission if you leave
- April - TBA** **AP Precoding Session for Seniors** – in the cafeteria during Advisory period
- April - TBA** **Graduation announcements delivered to students in 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> lunch.**
- May 1** **Caps, gowns, and graduation seating assignments will be issued during 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> lunch. The Code of Behavior form must completed online, all fees paid, all detentions, and attendance made up (ALA hours) before the cap and gown may be picked up.**
- May 6-17** **Advanced Placement Exams** – specific test dates will be posted on the MHS website
- May 13** **Senior Awards Night-** in the auditorium at 6:30 pm – invitations will be sent to specific students
- May 18** **All ALA (for excessive absences) and detention hours must be served to qualify for exemptions and to participate in graduation.**
- May 20** Exemption cards due in G-201. No cards will be accepted if you owe fines, fees, etc.
- May 21-24** **Final Exams. The specific schedule will be posted on the MHS website.**
- May 22 – 1 PM** **Graduation Rehearsal-** Attendance is required. Students must report to the Coliseum at **1:00 pm**. In the interest of time, it is extremely important to be prompt and to find your assigned seat immediately. Park on the east side of Tully and enter the coliseum through the tarmac.
- May 24** ALA hours (for excessive absences) must be served by this date to get credit for classes
- May 25** **Graduation-** Don Coleman Coliseum, 7:00 pm. Students **must** check in at 6:00 pm. **BE ON TIME**. Only students who have fulfilled all graduation requirements may participate in the ceremony. There is no limit on the number of guests. **Parking-** You must park at Stratford High School or the East side of Tully.
