Counseling Ministry exists to:

- Act as student advocate and catalyst for positive change.
- Be responsible for student records, schedules, tests and transcripts.
- Provide students guidance with personal and education goals.

The Counselors will:

- Assist students in setting realistic goals based on grades, test results and their personal profile.
- Facilitate parent conferences for teachers, students and parents to improve grades.
- Administer and interpret tests to assess academic and vocational interests.
- Counsel students with issues such as parent/teen conflict, drug use, peer pressure, social skills, etc.
- Make appropriate referrals to outside sources for intervention testing, etc.

Specific Tasks and Responsibilities:

- Work with the Vice Principal to ensure that students meet graduation requirements for high school and college.
- Provide college/career counseling for each junior and senior.
- Present “Parent Night” information regarding college admissions and financial aid for each grade level.
- Provide scholarship information to students.
- Act as a liaison with university recruiters and admissions offices.
- Keep parents and students informed of college information via the parent newsletter, website, daily bulletin, etc.
- Direct the test day for the PSAT and Pre ACT tests.
- Administer the placement Exam for admissions to 8th graders.
- Be available to students on an appointment basis for guidance counseling.
- Meet with each new student individually.
- Serve as a liaison between schools as well as other human services.
- Follow the teacher calendar with additional days as specified.

- Stay current with AMHS technology in addition to college application software (ie: Naviance, Power School, etc.)
