Upcoming Changes

- “Prior-prior” Year Validation of Tax Documents
 - Our process for current families will be moving to “prior-prior” year validation of tax forms.
 - For example:
 - THIS YEAR: When you apply for the 2019-2020 school year, we will review your 2017 taxes.
 - When you apply for the 2020-2021 school year, we will review your 2018 taxes.
 - When you apply for the 2021-2022 school year we will review your 2019 taxes.
- Early Deadline for current financial aid recipients
 - Starting in the fall of 2019, all current financial aid families will be required to submit their application by November 30, 2019.
- Early Financial Aid Decision Notification for Current financial aid recipients
 - Starting in 2020, all financial aid decisions will be sent with Re-enrollment Contract in early February 2020.

How does this affect you, a current financial aid recipient, for the current 2018-19 school year?

- This year’s deadline will remain the same: March 1, 2019.
- This year you must still fill out your Parent’s Financial Statement (PFS).
 - Use the 2018 column to enter your 2017 financial information
 - Use the 2019 column to enter your estimated 2018 financial information
- This year, current Breck financial aid recipients will be required to submit only their 2017 tax documents by the March 1, 2019 deadline. As you have already submitted them for last year’s financial aid application process, you have already completed this step of the application.
- If there has been a significant financial change to your situation, please provide an explanation using the “other consideration” section, found at the end of your PFS.
- **NEW:** All families must submit a copy of your most recent paycheck/pay-stub, which will allow for validation of your current financial situation. Please submit these materials by uploading them to your SSS account.

How does this affect you, a current financial aid recipient, for the 2019-20 school year and future school years?

- Starting the next academic year, 2019-2020, and all future years, we will move to an earlier financial aid application deadline: November 30, 2019.
- Starting the next academic year, 2019-2020, and all future years, you will receive your financial aid grant decision with your re-enrollment contract in early February, 2020.
