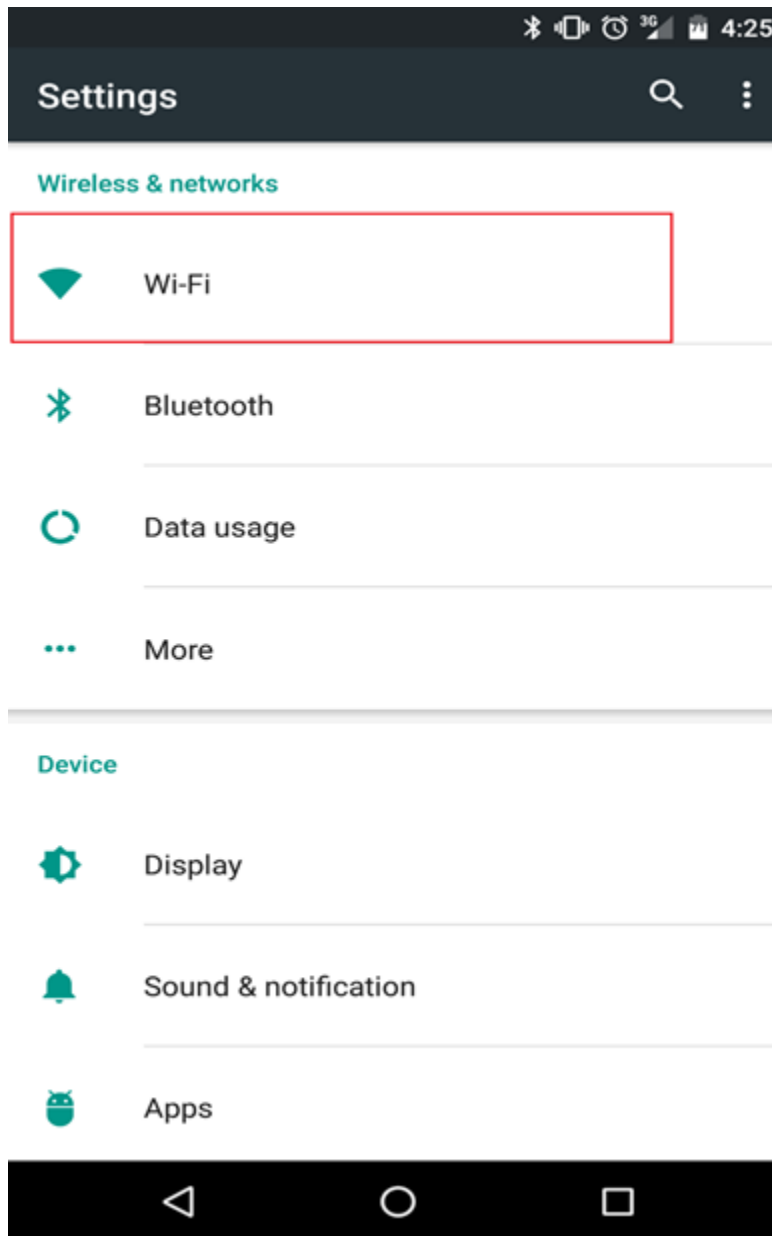
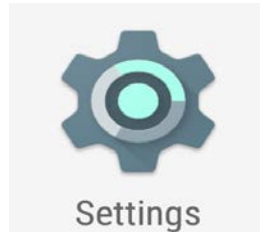

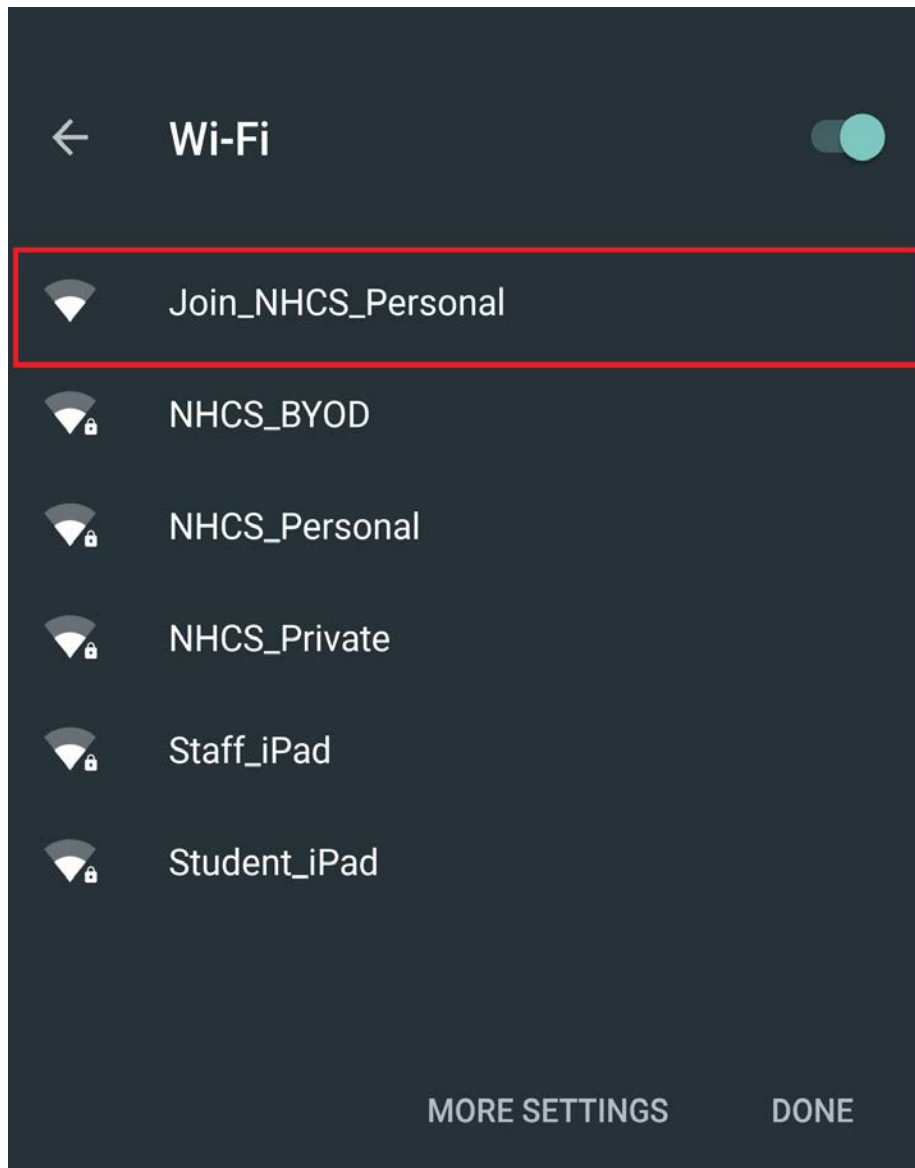

Step 1) Go to Settings then select WiFi



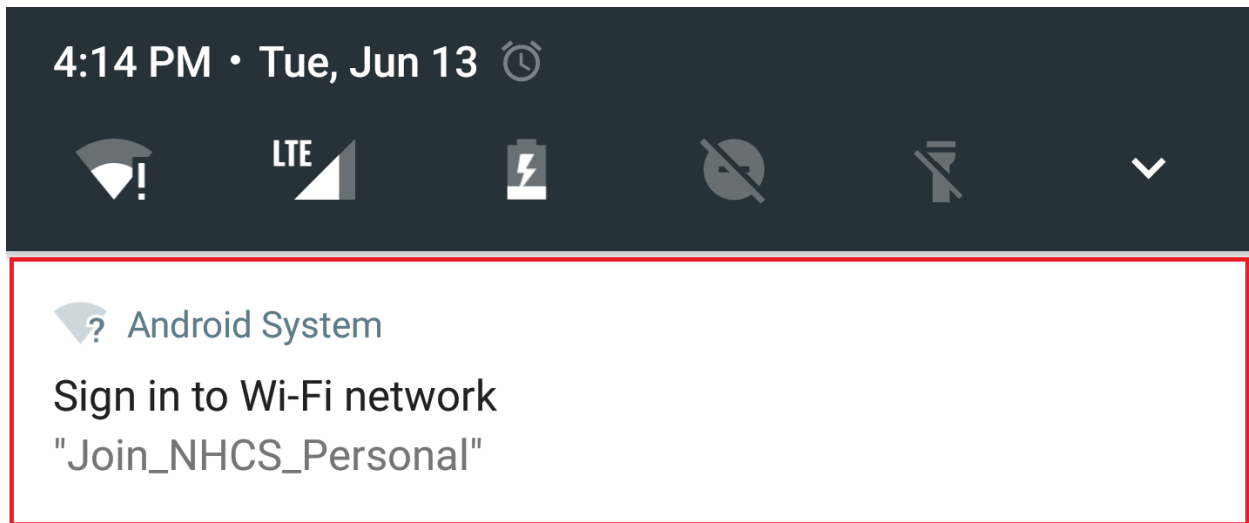

Step 2) Select Join_NHCS_Personal

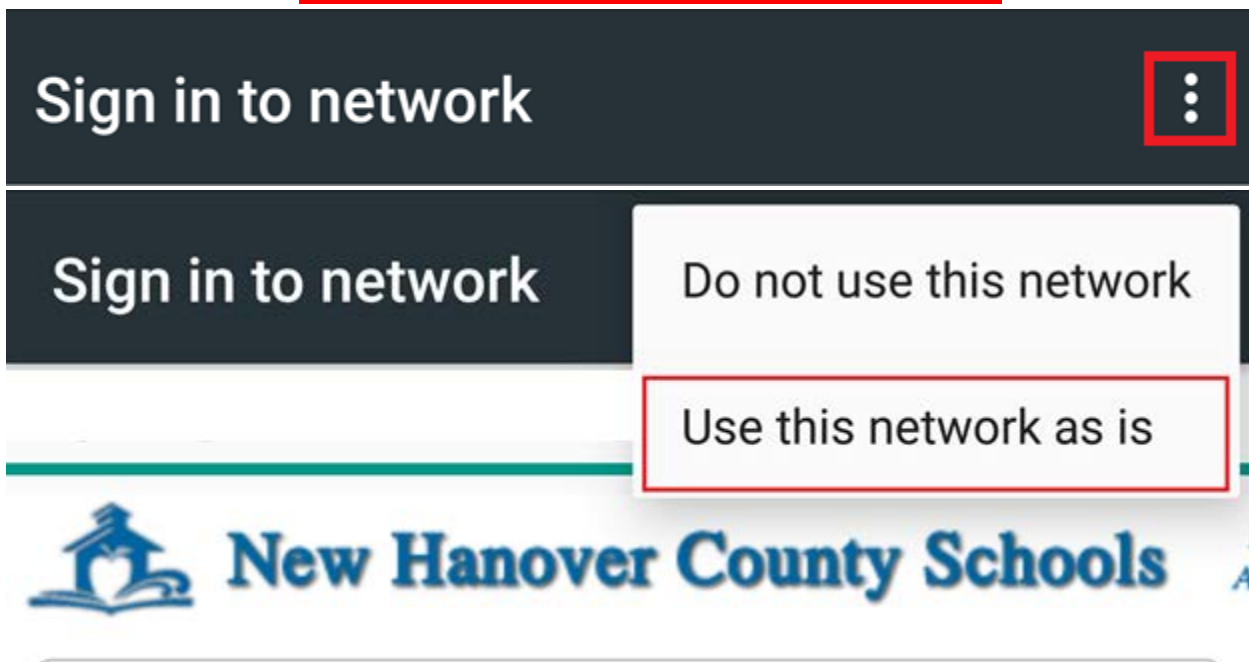
