What are we doing to address the space issue at the High School, the condition of Prairie Phoenix Academy Building, Ashley Field, and more?

The Secondary School Space Planning Committee (SSSPC) has been meeting since February 2018 to address these issues. This group meets twice per month and has spent time evaluating the existing needs, listening to the community, exploring options and will provide a recommendation to the School Board in December.

The tentative timeline for a secondary solution to be brought to the community to vote is Spring 2019.

Follow along with the SSSPC process by visiting the space planning webpage. Find meeting minutes, presentations, videos and more. The meetings are the first and third Wednesday of each month from 6 – 8:30 pm and are open to the public.

Watch for a community survey in September! We are looking forward to learning more about the community's interest as we evaluate secondary space options.



DID YOU KNOW?

Each school year there are over 85,000 visits to our school nurse offices. Our school health services team is made up of two District Health Nurses and a Health Assistant at each school building. Together we work to remove health related learning barriers, and create a healthy and safe learning environment for all children. Our department offers training opportunities for both staff and students to help them be prepared to respond to health emergencies, including CPR, First Aid, and Stop the Bleed classes.


DID YOU KNOW?

DID YOU KNOW?

Started in 1989, the Sun Prairie Business & Education Partnership (BEP) is a group of educators and community business people who focus on uniting schools and businesses to help students prepare for their futures. Initially starting with just a couple of programs, the group now runs 13-15 projects every year. Every project that BEP has sponsored has come from a teacher/administrator who saw a need to get the business community involved. BEP members provide their time to assist in our schools with programs like Reading Buddies, GRIT, Adopt-a-School, Reality Rocks, and more.

In the Reading Buddy program, a BEP member is partnered with a first grade classroom and reads to students once a month. Students receive their own copies of the book to take home to create their own home libraries. In the fall of 2018, all first grades in the district had BEP Reading Buddies, even the two new elementary schools. 

DID YOU KNOW?

All Sun Prairie School District school buildings have earned the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) ENERGY STAR certification the last three years, with many certifications dating back to 2009. Buildings are rated on EPA's 1-100 scale, with scores 75 or higher required for eligibility for ENERGY STAR certification. Certification signifies that the buildings perform in the top 25 percent of similar facilities nationwide for energy efficiency and meet strict energy efficiency performance levels set by the EPA. Sun Prairie school buildings scores range from 79 to 98, with an average over 88. Commercial buildings that earn EPA's ENERGY STAR certification use an average of 35 percent less energy than typical buildings and also release 35 percent less carbon dioxide into the atmosphere.
