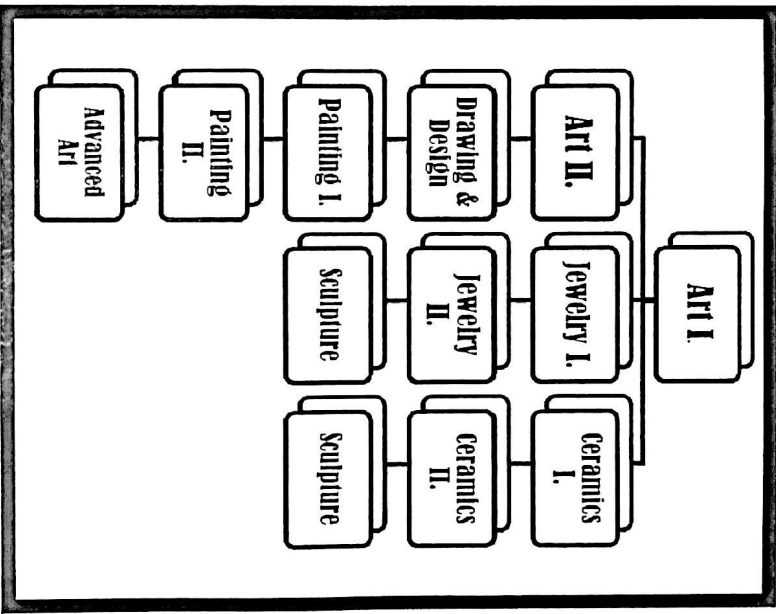


# Billings West High Art Courses

- **Art I**  
A basic exploratory course covering a variety of art activities.
- **Art II**  
Emphasizes more advanced utilization of the concepts, media, and techniques learned in Art I.
- **Jewelry I**  
Create 3-D jewelry designs such as metal forming, casting, piercing, and stone setting.
- **Jewelry II**  
Students will be exposed to more advanced metal techniques and design, requiring higher degree of physical and mental abilities.
- **Ceramics I**  
Students are exposed to hand-built, wheel-thrown, and combination techniques and glazing.
- **Ceramics II**  
Build on techniques and skills learned in Ceramics I.

- **Drawing and Design**  
Develop advanced techniques in a variety of drawing and design media.
- **Painting I**  
Emphasizes techniques in oils and acrylics. Projects include themes related to realism, abstraction, and working with one's imagination.
- **Painting II**  
Expands on the Painting I concepts and techniques as they apply to oils, acrylics, and watercolor.
- **Sculpture**  
Focuses on the development and production of 3-dimensional art forms.
- **Advanced Art**  
Students have the option of contracting to work in one or more media, such as: painting, drawing, ceramics, and sculpture, etc.
- **All art courses are one semester.**
