AP and CE

AP- Advanced Placement

- Nationally recognized
- Credit accepted by most colleges
- Most classes are full year
- Take test in May (\$94.00)
- Must pass with 3 or higher
- Receive 5-6 credits per class

CE- Concurrent Enrollment

- Accepted by most state colleges
- Classes are sem. or full year
- Credit is based on grade received
- Grades appear on college transcript
- Typically receive 3 credits per class

Letter of Completion

One year of general education requirements completed by graduation.

- 4 years English
- 4 years progressive Math

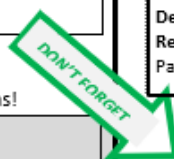
