- Knowing about what is required in the next level class


Their weakness:


Your Superpower:


- You know you best! You know how motivated you are and what interests you. You know how hard you are willing to work. You know your extra responsibilities – sports, clubs, job etc.

Their Weakness:


• They do not know the specifics on each class, the amount of work required or what may be needed or not needed for college.

What does this all mean when choosing classes?

- Be reflective what classes sound interesting? Where will you put in the effort and work?
- Balance think about how much time you have during the day/week to get work done. What other responsibilities do you have? Don't forget sleep, eating and social time.
- Appropriately challenging you do not want to overwhelm yourself, nor do you want to coast through. You have to pick classes that provide the appropriate amount of challenge for YOU. This is going to be different for everyone and that is ok.

The Waiver Process

What if you were not recommended for an Honors or AP class and you would like to take it? This is where the waiver process comes in. How does this work?

- Have a parent contact current subject area teacher to discuss getting a parent waiver.
- Be sure to submit any parent waiver to your teacher before February 15th .
- No student who earned or is currently earning a D or lower in a class will get a parent waiver.
- Do NOT ask for a conversation or waiver on the last day of registration, plan ahead and do it early.

- Please submit a special request if you plan on taking AP Government and other core academic classes or are continuing with Media, Computer or Fine Arts and you don't have room for Economics.
- You must register for US Gov and Econ and submit a special request form for use to change it to AP Government and provide info about our summer Economics options.
