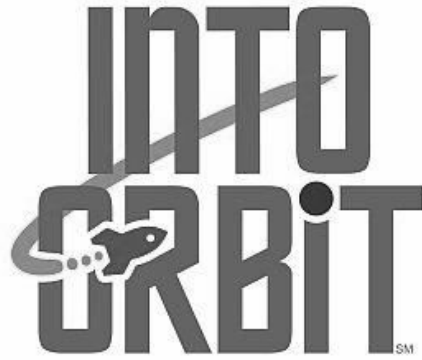


BURLINGTON SCIENCE CENTER PRESENTS:
