## Head Varsity Hockey Coach



### Overview

Cardigan Mountain School is a junior boarding and day school for boys in grades six through nine, located in Canaan, New Hampshire. The School seeks to employ individuals who will share our commitment to supporting the School's mission: "To offer a close-knit community that prepares middle school boys—in mind, body, and spirit—for responsible and meaningful lives in a global society." ### The Position

Cardigan Mountain School seeks an experienced and committed coach and educator to lead the Varsity Hockey Team and Ice Hockey Program beginning in the 2019-2020 school year. The coaching position is a full-time, 10-month faculty position. The ideal candidate will have a strong background in playing and coaching hockey, possess a passion and commitment to player development as student-athletes, and have experience as a classroom teacher and residential supervisor. The position works closely with our Director of Athletics and reports to the Dean of Faculty.

### Specific Responsibilities

The Head Varsity Hockey Coach will:

- Coach the varsity hockey team and direct daily on and off-ice practices during the winter season
- Lead and supervise all coaches and teams in the hockey program
- Work with the Admissions Office to recruit prospective student-athletes and counsel athletes in meeting future goals
- Assist the Secondary School Counseling Office with placement of hockey players
- Teach up to three academic sections
- Serve as an advisor to students
- Supervise a dormitory floor
- Participate in our clubs program

### Qualifications

The ideal candidate will possess the following qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree required; Master's degree preferred
- Previous coaching/teaching experience. Experience in a middle school environment preferred, but not required
- Interest in and demonstrated skill in working with adolescent boys
- A shared commitment to an inclusive community, and respect for differences
- Ability to make contributions to School life across multiple facets of our program
- Willingness to embrace and engage in the active lifestyle of an independent boarding school
