AGENDA ITEMS	DISCUSSION AND DECISIONS
Introductions	Scott called to order 5:36pm. Committee members introduced themselves
Review purpose of committee	To review the HG&D curriculum and to make a recommendation to the school board.
Discussion	<p>The committee reviewed the timeline for the committee’s process, what has been completed and what remains for the rest of their work. The next step is to gather input on the lessons and materials that district staff developed and gathered to fit with the Board of Education approved outcomes. Along with the Advisory Committee reviewing the Ubd’s, there will be 2 community sessions to gather input on February 7, 2019.</p> <p>Tanya and Scott thanked the team involved in researching materials and developing the lessons. The decision to collect input electronically was made to ensure transparency, allow for 24/7 access and to ensure the information it can’t get lost or not returned.</p> <p>It was explained that a parent notification letter which includes a list of topics, how to view materials and how to opt out will be distributed and available multiple ways. The letter will include links to the Ubd, curriculum, lessons and resources. It was noted that per state law, families cannot opt out of the Personal Safety strand.</p>

	<p>Those in attendance took some time to get acclimated to this review process. Group was encouraged to review all lessons if possible. AC thanked those that developed the access to the lessons and materials.</p> <p>Time allowed for any final questions. Question was asked if Health will be taken in 9th or 10th grade. AC would like it to be encouraged for kids to take it in 9th grade. The communication on this change is to come.</p>
