Introductions	Scott called to order 5:36pm. Committee members introduced themselves
Review purpose of committee	To review the HG&D curriculum and to make a recommendation to the school board.
Discussion	 The committee reviewed the timeline for the committee's process, what has been completed and what remains for the rest of their work. The next step is to gather input on the lessons and materials that district staff developed and gathered to fit with the Board of Education approved outcomes. Along with the Advisory Committee reviewing the Ubd's, there will be 2 community sessions to gather input on February 7, 2019. Tanya and Scott thanked the team involved in researching materials and developing the lessons. The decision to collect input electronically was made to ensure transparency, allow for 24/7 access and to ensure the information it can't get lost or not returned.
