

### Battle of the Books Updates:

Battle of the Books (BOB) is a voluntary reading incentive program for 4th and 5th graders that culminates in a quiz-style competition. The purpose is to encourage students to read good books and have fun while doing it!

Any 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> grade student wanting to learn more about Battle of the Books is invited to attend an informational meeting on Tuesday, December 18 in the library afterschool. Parent pick up is at 3:15.

Students interested in Battle of the Books will meet on Tuesdays after school beginning February 12 to talk about the books and practice with competition-style questions. All meetings will be held in the library with parent pick up at 3:15.

Ogden's School Battle will be held on Friday, March 15 at 8:00 am. Students who wish to try out for the team will take a 2 part test on Tuesday, March 19. Parent pick up is at 3:15.

- Match the book title with the author
- Students will identify the book title and author based on a quote from the book. For example, "In which book did a pig compete at the county fair?"  
Answer: Charlotte's Web by EB White

The students with the top 6 scores will represent Ogden at the district level Battle of the Books on Thursday, May 2 at the NHC Northeast Branch Library at Landfall.
