Calling All COBIS Schools – A chance to showcase your school and your students in a COBIS Film!

COBIS is pleased to be working with [Eye Film](#), once again, to prepare an exciting new film that will be showcased at our [38th COBIS Annual Conference – Vision 2030: The Future of International Education](#) in London in May. This project will showcase the global COBIS family of schools and we would love to invite your school to contribute.

This film will highlight the thoughts and visions of COBIS students and teachers from around the world. We particularly want to hear from your students about their vision for 2030 and what they think the future holds for international education. Schools are invited to submit short clips which might involve students completing the following statements:

- In 2030, I will be...
- My education is preparing me for the future by...
- In 2030, schools will be... (will they change? If so, how?)
- In 2030, teaching will... (how will it be different?)
- In 2030, children will learn...(how?)
- In 2030, the school day will be...(what will it look like?)
- In 2030, school dinners will be...
- In 2030, teachers and students will get to school by...
- In 2030, technology in schools will...
- In 2030, I will look back to my school years and remember...
- In 2030, COBIS will be engaging schools and students by...

We would also love to hear from your teaching staff. Please feel free to use the following questions as cues when filming your staff:

- It's the year 2030: What are you doing?
- Describe one aspect of teaching/learning that you think will have changed the most in 2030.
- Describe one way you would like education to be different in the future.
- What do you think your classroom will look like in 2030?
- Do you think more children will have access to education in 2030?
- What is the main way your school is adapting for the future?
- Name one way in which you prepare students for the future.
- Give us your three top skills pupils will need for the future.
- What do you think will be the biggest difference in the 2030 curriculum (compared to now)?
- In what key way do you predict pedagogy will evolve?
- What do you think will be a typical day for students in 2030?
- What do you think will be the top three benefits of COBIS membership in 2030?

Other possible contributions could include:

- A group of students at a point in/around the school which showcases the unique, international location saying 'Hi from School X'
- Images/shots of students engaging in activities/lessons that will prepare them for the future
- A short animation
- Sporting shots, musical performances, etc.

Please be **creative** with your submissions. We are leaving it to the schools' and students' imaginations to decide what should be submitted.

- Be sure to incorporate the name/location of your school in the footage where possible so that this is clear in the final edited film.
- Include visuals to support your statements (e.g. if a student says 'In 2030 children will learn using technology', try to include technology in the shot)

Technical information

- Schools can submit raw footage without editing, background music, etc. – Eye Film will do the final editing
- Clips should be no longer than 1 minute
- Schools should submit a maximum of 5 clips
- Please send video footage in as high quality as possible, at least HD 720, or as HD 1080/4K. Preferred video formats are mpeg4 or .mov files, not .wmv or .flv. If you have any questions or difficulties, please email charlie@eyefilm.co.uk
- Still images can also be submitted; please submit high resolution JPEG images or raw files if you have them
- Please try to get the best possible sound for any talking in your footage – the best solution would be to use a separate microphone rather than an in-built camera microphone if you have one.

How to submit your clips

- Schools should upload their video clips using WeTransfer (www.wetransfer.com) and then send the link to charlie@eyefilm.co.uk stating in the Message "Video for COBIS" and the name of the School. WeTransfer is explained here: www.wetransfer.com/howitworks. Up to 2GB can be sent this way. If you have any difficulties using WeTransfer, or if you would like to use other file transfer services please email charlie@eyefilm.co.uk

- The deadline for submitting clips is **Friday 5 April 2019**
