What is Lunch & Learn?

- Lunch & Learn is 60-minute break in the day from 10:27-11:27
- Lunch & Learn will provide students with multiple opportunities to meet with teachers and peers
- Lunch & Learn will allow students to take a break during the day

Why are we doing Lunch & Learn?

- During the 2017-18 school year, a scheduling committee was formed to examine the schedules at UHS and CFPMS and survey data was compiled from all stakeholder groups
- What we learned from the surveys:
 - ***Strong interest in maintaining current seven period schedule***
 - ***Teacher collaboration time was noted as a significant area of concern for teachers in our current schedule***
 - ***Strong interest from students and parents in having an hour Lunch and Learn***
 - ***Students and teachers needed more time to access one another***

How does Lunch & Learn work?

- Lunch will be divided into two parts each day:
 - Lunch 1/Learn 1 (10:27-10:57)
 - Lunch 2/Learn 2 (10:57-11:27)
- Students will be free from (10:27-11:27), and teachers will have a 30-minute lunch and a 30-minute classroom availability

What is changing due to Lunch & Learn?

- Homerooms will no longer meet
 - Attendance taken during 1st period
- There will be a four-minute passing time between classes
- Multiple bells will no longer ring during the school day

****Senior Privilege will still be available****

Student Safety During Lunch & Learn?

- As is always the case each day at Unionville High School, student safety is of the UTMOST importance
- During Lunch & Learn students will be in various locations throughout the high school, and there will be multiple staff members with walkie-talkies walking in the building monitoring student behavior

****Students MAY NOT leave the UHS Campus during Lunch & Learn!***

Student Safety During Lunch & Learn?

- There will be new evacuation processes put into place for evacuation drills that will be practiced during Lunch & Learn:
 - Students will now report to 1st period teacher location regardless of period.
 - 1st period Senior privilege students will report to the football field end zone closest to the parking lot. There will be teacher monitors at these locations to take attendance.

Does Everyone Need to Eat in the Cafeteria at the Same Time?

- The simple answer is, No!
- Students will be able to eat at multiple locations throughout the building
- Lunch & Learn provides flexibility for where students can eat
- Food will be served each day at:
 - Cafeteria - 1st Floor
 - Gym Lobby - 1st Floor
 - Expanded Offerings at Cyber Cafe - 2nd Floor

What Can I Do During Lunch & Learn?

- Eat lunch
- Access teachers
- Complete school work/projects (Study hall)
- Participate in study groups
- Take part in recreational activities (gymnasiums/courtyards)
- Exercise
- Decompress

****Students MAY NOT leave the UHS Campus during Lunch & Learn!***



Where Can I Go During Lunch & Learn?

- Locations with Adult Supervision Will Vary From Day to Day

Where Will My Teachers Be During Lunch & Learn?

- One of the key components of Lunch & Learn is to provide students with more access to their teachers
- Teachers will maintain office hours for 30 min. for 5/6 days per cycle for students to access them for questions and help.
- Teachers will have collaboration time with their department 1/6 days in the cycle to encourage professional development, dialogue, creativity, and consistency.



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
