This did not deter the Gophers as they won the Three Rivers Conference; beat Austin-Pacelli in the state qualifying game; and went on to play a tough Kasson-Mantorville team in the state quarter-finals in which the Gophers were defeated 24-8. 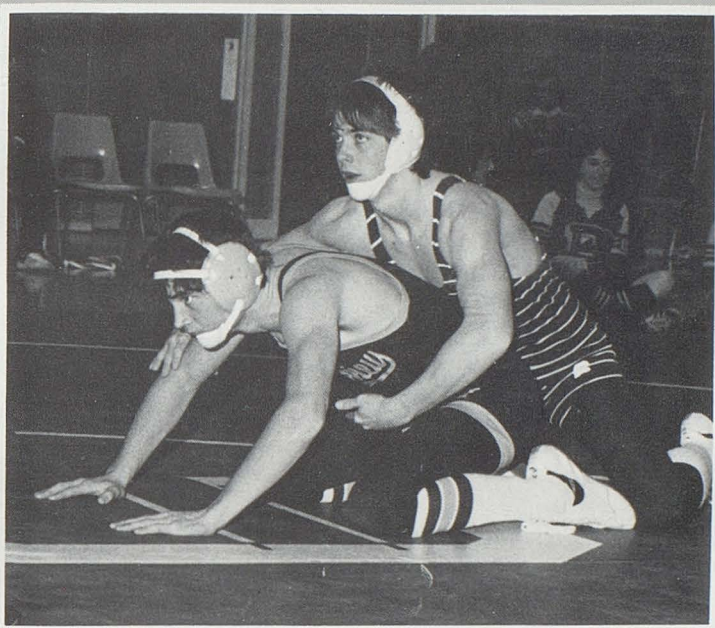
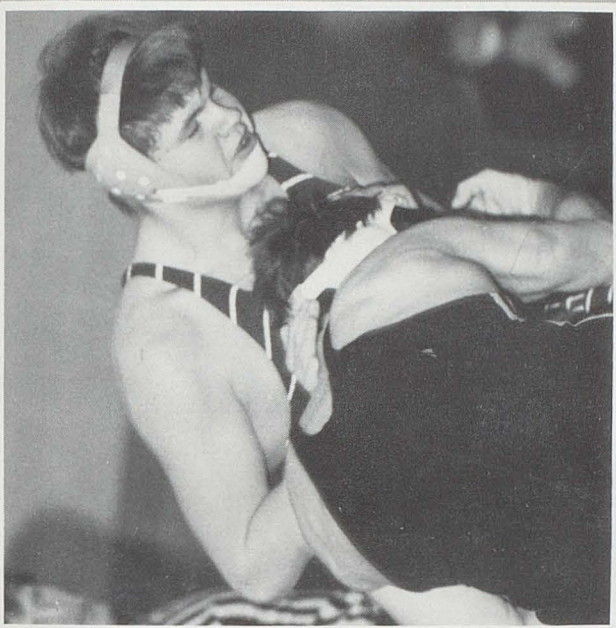
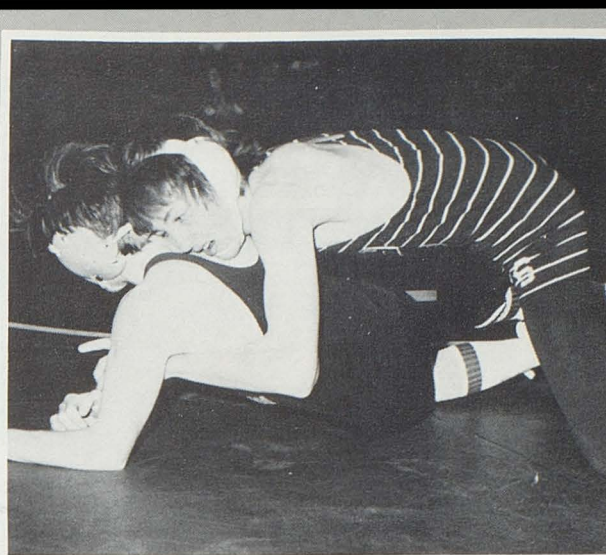
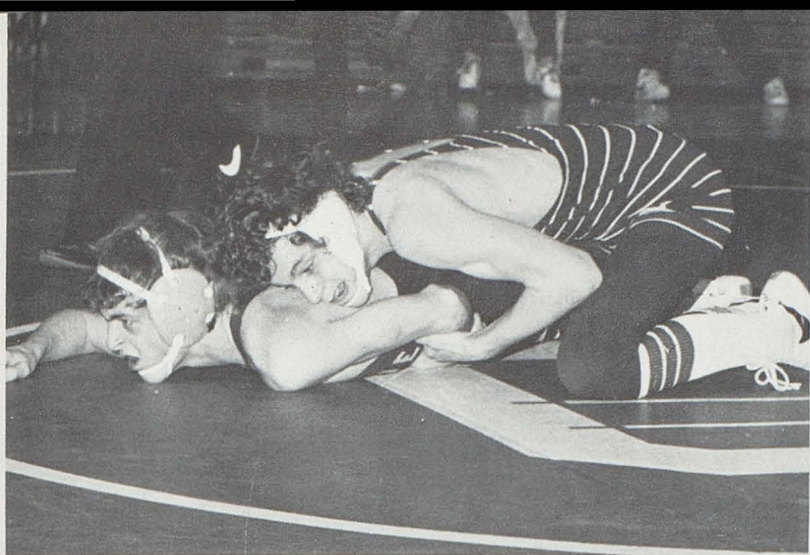
Our school can be proud of our wrestling team's effort and the individuals successes of each teammate, especially those of Pat Clemens, Larry Ward, and Eric Luoma.

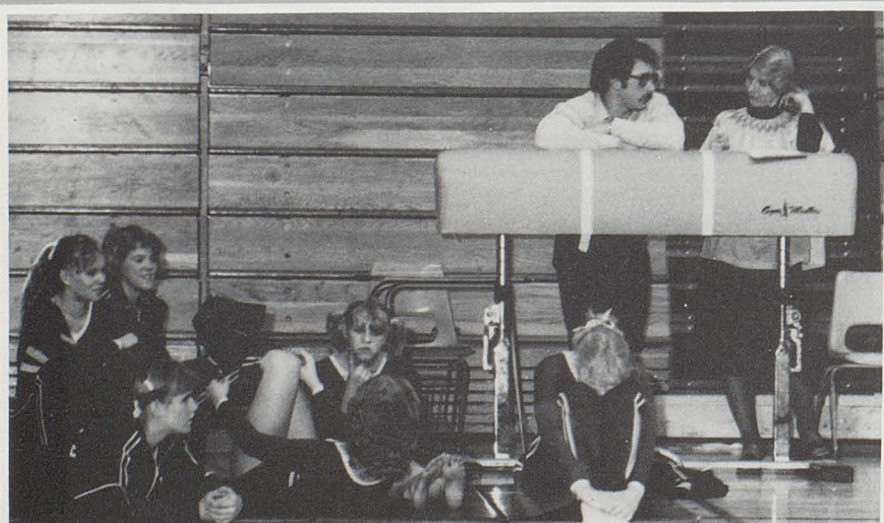

Most of the team's exciting moments occurred toward the end of the season when it succeeded in placing 4th of 13 teams at the Pine Island Invitational, 1st of 3 teams at a home meet, and placing 3rd in the Three Rivers Conference meet at which many of the girls turned in personal bests. Angie Zimmerman set a new school record in the 200-meter low hurdles with a time of 33.8, and at districts Dawn Schriever set a school record in the long jump-17' 17" (1st place.) Individual speech competition is an extracurricular activity sponsored by the Minnesota State High School League. There are eleven speech categories of which you may enter one. The events which include original speech categories of which you may enter one. The events which include original speeches discussion of your own ideas are original oratory, creative expression, extemporaneous speaking and discussion. The remaining events-interpretatio of serious prose, poetry, drama, humor, storytelling, extemporaneous reading, and non-original oratory-are interpretations of the writings of others.

Snow Week

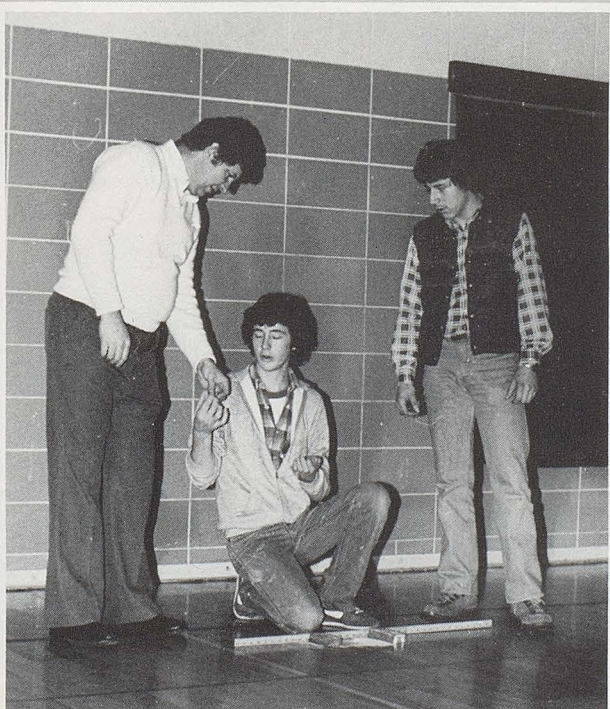
