#### FOOTBALL

One of the finest football seasons in recent years ended when Chatfield overpowered Hayfield, 34-0. This game gave the Chatfield Gophers an undefeated season with a 9-0 record. Under the capable coaching of Mr. Wistrom, Mr. Converse, Mr. Ziebell, and Mr. Brown, the Gophers were ranked 13th and 25th in two separate state wide football polls. The team was ranked one of the finest football teams in southeastern Minnesota and they also walked off with the Maple Leaf Conference Championship.

Chatfield opened the season with a 14-0 victory over St. Charles. Houston was the next victim, 47-14. On September 31, the Chatfield-Harmony game was the game of the week in Minnesota. Harmony had a 30 plus game streak without a loss at stake. When the game was over the Gophers had a 37-6 victory. Preston, 19-0 and Wykoff, 31-0, were the next victims to feel the Gopher power. Lanesboro came to Chatfield on October 12th. This was Homecoming and also the Maple Leaf Conference title was at stake. A hard fought game ended with Chatfield winning 14-0 and in the drivers seat for the title. The Gophers closed the season by winning the remaining three games, Spring Valley, 32-7, Dover-Eyota, 41-0, and Hayfield, 34-0. The seasons total were 269 points scored for Chatfield and 27 points for the opponents.

The Chatfield players on the Maple Leaf All Conference Squads were Bill Rowen, Dick Tuohy, and Wayne King on the offense and defense squads. Dick Bradt made the defensive squad and Dennis Hanson was placed on the offensive squad.
