1991 Gopher Football - "A season to be remembered"

The 1991 football season was one that will stand as probably the "oddest" season that the Gophers have had in many years. The season had its ups and downs, ins and outs (in to the Domes and out of the cold, that is), and definitely much excitement.


The Gophers were picked as pre-season contenders for the Three Rivers Crown but some key injuries put those hopes to rest as they started out the season 0-4. Playoff chances were getting smaller after each loss, but the Gophers kept at it. They managed to win 3 out of their last 4 games and took the final playoff spot with a 3-5 record.

Their first playoff game was against the top-ranked Harmony Cardinals. The Gopher's offense exploded and the defense tightened up as they went on the defeat Harmony 22-7. The following week Chatfield took on Mabel-Canton. The offense continued to be on fire as the racked up 48 points and defeated the Cougars quite handily. At this point, everything was looking great for the Gophers, except the weather. An early snowstorm left the team and its fans not knowing if, where, or when the next game would be held. But the excitement continued as they were off to the Uni-Dome in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, to take on Rushford-Peterson for the Section title and a state playoff berth.

It was a hard-hitting, exciting ball game that was punctuated by a 22-play, 90 plus yard drive that gave the Gophers a touchdown with little time remaining. The Trojans couldn't score and the Gophers won the Section title 12-7.

The state playoffs were held in the Metro Dome in Minneapolis because of the weather and fans poured into the Dome to watch the Gophers take on Mankato-Loyola. The two teams were evenly matched and Gopher fans cheered on as their team took an 8-6 lead with a little over 7 minutes remaining. But, the Crusaders made a final dive that put them on the 2 yard line with 24 seconds remaining. They were able to successfully kick a 19 yard field goal that ended the game and the Gopher's season. 


