## **Isa Makhuli – Swimming**

At the NCISAA State Championship meet, freshman Isa Makhuli took 4th overall in the girls 500 freestyle swimming, a lifetime best time by 4 seconds. She also made finals and took 13th overall in a highly competitive field of swimmers in the 100 Butterfly, achieving another lifetime best time by 1 second. Makhuli was also a key swimmer on two Charger relays, the 400 Freestyle Relay that took 8th (with a lifetime best 100 free on her relay split) and the 200 Medley Relay that took 9th (season best 50 Butterfly split).

## **Ikem Ekwonu - Wrestling**

Senior wrestling and team captain Ikem Ekwonu repeated as the CISAA Conference Champion in the heavyweight class with an impressive first period pin against his opponent. Ikem's record on the year is now 30 wins vs only 6 loses. This places him in a strong position as he builds towards winning a state title this upcoming week.
