



Lake Forest Academy Cell Phone Policy

Due to the high level of distractions that cell phones have caused in our learning environment, we have established a school-wide cell phone policy for our students. While student cell phone use is a privilege in all New Hanover County schools, students must understand that it is not a right for them to have cell phones at school. Our school is furnished with 25 phones, with one phone in each classroom. With the availability of so many phones on our campus, we do not see a need for students to bring their phone to school. Our policy is as follows:

- Students are to leave cell phones at home at all times.
- If a cell phone is seen or heard by any staff member, the phone will be confiscated and given to the Principal to be locked up.
- A parent/guardian will be notified that the phone has been confiscated.
- Any confiscated phones will be returned to the parent at the end of the semester.
- If your child must have a phone for after school purposes, you must sign to agree to the following terms:
 - Your child will be required to turn their phone in to the front office.
 - The phone will be locked up during the school day.
 - Your child may pick up their phone at the end of the day.
