In September, with much fanfare, we gathered to dedicate Phase I of the Vision of Promise Campaign: The Howard Center for the Arts. Barry and Elayne Howard, along with Archbishop Charles Chaput and representatives from the Office of Catholic Education, joined members of the Alumni Association, RCHS Board of Directors, and present Roman students to officially cut the ribbon and dedicate the building.

It was a most memorable day in the history of our beloved school. We are eternally indebted to Barry and Elayne for their unparalleled commitment and support. It is such an honor for us, that our newest building bears their name!

Just think about it – our original building was constructed in the 19th Century, the McSherry Annex was built in the 20th Century, and now our newest facility, the Howard Center, was constructed in the 21st Century. In our 129th year of operation, Roman has a true Center City campus, composed of three independent buildings. Roman students can be seen traveling to and from the various buildings, attending a variety of classes in a college-like setting.

Not to lose any momentum, our attention is now focused on raising funds for Phase II of the Vision of Promise Campaign – a new STEM Center. To ensure that our students are able

to compete in a global marketplace, where math and science literacy skills are indispensable, we need to upgrade our science and technology facilities and course offerings. The STEM Center, to be built on the parking lot of the 1890 building, is estimated to cost \$7 million and will contain seven additional classrooms dedicated to science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.

This reinvestment, this commitment to Roman Catholic, is unparalleled. While Catholic Schools in our City, and throughout the nation, are experiencing difficult and challenging times, Roman Catholic is experiencing a new renaissance, a time of substantial growth and expansion. All of this is possible because of your continued support.

Words are certainly inadequate to express our depths of gratitude to you for the generosity expressed in this Annual Report. We would not be where we are as a school without your commitment. So, no matter what your donation, no matter how big or small, please know the students of Catholic High remain grateful for your investment in them.

The Dedication and Grand Opening of The Howard Center for the Arts

On Tuesday, September 18th, Roman Catholic High School celebrated the grand opening and formal dedication of The Howard Center for the Arts. The 40,000 square foot center is named after Barry & Elayne Howard, longtime supporters of the students of Roman. Barry has served as a dedicated member of Roman’s Board of Directors since its inception over 25 years ago.

The day of celebration began with a formal luncheon in the McShain Media Center located in main building. Distinguished guests, alumni, friends, and current students enjoyed a great

meal together while honoring the Howards for their commitment to advancing the mission of Roman Catholic. Once lunch adjourned, the festivities continued in the parking garage on the first level of the Howard Center with a larger public crowd in attendance. The dedication began when Elayne Howard had the distinct honor of cutting the ribbon and officially opening the Howard Center for the Arts!

Then Master of Ceremonies, Chris Gibbons ’79, Vice President of the Alumni Association gave the call to order. Multiple speeches and poignant remarks were made by various leaders of the Roman community and of course the Howards themselves. Amidst the

speeches was a wonderful performance by the school chorus. The ceremony was concluded with Archbishop Charles J. Chaput conducting a prayer service of dedication to the new education facility. After the event, guests received tours of the beautiful new building and enjoyed a reception in the Black Box Theater. It was a historic and memorable day in Roman Catholic High School’s storied history.

The Howard Center for the Arts is the realization of Phase One of Roman Catholic High School’s Vision of Promise master plan – a four-phased, \$25 million, transformational initiative which will provide an innovative, 21st Century environment for Roman’s

students. Subsequent phases of the Vision of Promise plan will include:

- A science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) building with modern lab facilities (Phase II)
- A new field house with indoor track to accommodate the school’s celebrated athletic programs (Phase III)
- The repurposing of the current gymnasium to include an auditorium and chapel. Additionally, updated space will be provided for a College Careers and Counseling Center, Academic Affairs, Admissions and Student Affairs offices (Phase IV)

The new campus will be anchored around the original historic school building, which has been in continuous use since 1890. An update on the Vision of Promise campaign including details on the challenge grant can be found on page 6.

“I am proud of Roman’s commitment to the Arts at a time when many other schools are eliminating or curtailing art, music and drama classes,” said Rev. Joseph Bongard, president and rector of Roman Catholic High School. “These programs foster creativity that students will need to adapt to an ever-changing world and excel in college and beyond.”

The new building has created available space for Roman to start several additional construction projects. The former art studio has been converted into a brand new Exercise and Wellness Center. A new Mock Trial Courtroom is also currently being constructed in the attic of the 1890 building, a space formally occupied by the music program, to help our internationally ranked Mock Trial team refine their courtroom skills.

Among the provisions of the bill is an exclusion from gross income for income tax purposes of up to \$100,000 (for each IRA account owner) for “qualified charitable distributions” from an IRA. The distribution will count toward an individual’s Required Minimum Distribution (RMD).

GIFTS OF STOCK OR SECURITIES: A gift of appreciated stock or securities will go a long way to help Roman Catholic





Ways to Continue the Cahill Legacy

Give Online: Gifts can be made online through our secure server. Visit www.romancatholicsh.com/donate and give any time.

Give by Mail or Phone: Cash, Check, and Credit Card gifts can always be made by direct mail. Checks can be made out to "Roman Catholic High School" and mailed to 301 N. Broad Street, Philadelphia, PA, 19107. Gifts can also be made over the phone via credit card by calling (215)-627-5487.

Match your Gift: Many companies offer matching gift policies that can double (or more) a contribution made to Roman by one of its employees. Check with your human resources department or the Office of Advancement to find out if your employer will match your gift.

IRA Rollover: This summary describes the important advantages and steps in making a qualified charitable distribution from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA), commonly referred to as a IRA charitable rollover.

Legislation enacted in December 2015 authorized charitable gifts from IRAs. Among the provisions of the bill is an exclusion from gross income for income tax purposes of up to \$100,000 (for each IRA account owner) for "qualified charitable distributions" from an IRA. The distribution will count toward an individual's Required Minimum Distribution (RMD).

Plan your Gift: There are a variety of estate and planned giving opportunities, including gifts of securities, bequests, retirement assets, charitable trusts, insurance, IRA rollovers, stocks and annuities, retained life estate and other assets.

Sustain your Gift: Decide how much you want to contribute and your bank will automatically deduct your gift from your account on a monthly basis. A modest gift given every month can equal a significant gift by year's end.

EITC/OSTC Program: Pennsylvania's Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) and Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit (OSTC) programs allow businesses and individuals to direct the monies they pay in taxes to go towards providing financial aid and scholarships for Roman students. For a one year commitment you receive a tax credit for 75% of your contribution. For a two year commitment you receive a tax credit for 90% of your contribution. It is easy to apply! What led the Flach family in choosing Roman Catholic for their sons?

There are many options for high school with where we live, but our oldest Colin, was drawn to Roman from the start. Several older boys from Glenside were starting to attend Roman. Upon visiting, Colin and several 8th grade classmates from St. Luke really started to get a sense of what a great school Roman is, how many activities were offered. He got a taste of the brotherhood that exists among Roman students that lasts the rest of their lives. The boys all had several other options for high school, but in the end their hearts said "Roman". The boys also have Roman in their blood, with their grandfather Michael Flach '51 and four of their older cousins also graduating from Roman. As parents, Roman felt like home, and although the boys ultimately made their own decisions, we couldn't be happier about all of their experiences so far.

How were, or are your sons involved at Roman?

Colin '17 played freshman football, and four years of basketball. He was lucky to be a part of two PCL championship games at the Palestra. He also participated in collecting coats at Roman for a winter coat drive, and Speak Up! He is currently a sophomore at Chestnut Hill College and playing basketball. Danny '19 has played golf for four years, and has been one of the managers on the basketball team for four years as well. He is also a member of the National Honor Society and after his sophomore year traveled to Europe with other RCHS students. Danny also was a Kairos Retreat leader as a Junior. Michael '21 has played golf for two years, as well as being a member of the basketball program. He is talking about reviving his baseball career this year and would like to run for Student Council.

How has Roman impacted you as a family, as parents, and for each individual son?

We have had amazing experiences and memories so far. Every boy is different and they all have taken different paths. Colin went to Roman with 10+ kids from his grade school

class so it was easier for him. Danny and Michael saw those experiences that Colin was having, and that really sold them. But they both had a smaller group from grade school go to Roman with them. That has forced them to branch out. They have been able to make friends from all over the city and all walks of life.

Roman has also taught them independence. Going from our little incubated town of Glenside where the boys can walk to school and to their friends' houses, they were always accounted for. The train trips and independence of commuting to Roman was an adjustment for everyone, including Mom and Dad. But that experience has prepared them for beyond high school and has helped them step out of their comfort zone.

Academically, all three boys are different, but all three have been successful in their own ways at Roman. They have had great teachers and mentors who have always had their best interests at heart. We truly believe they have been prepared for the college level and beyond, not only academically, but socially as well.

Editor's Note: In 2010, the Flach Family established the "Kevin from Heaven" Scholarship & Foundation, in honor of their late son, Kevin.

Their son Kevin would be a member of this year's Freshman Class, the

Class of 2022. Kevin was the middle child and their 4th born son. He so much looked up to his older brothers Colin, Danny and Michael, and did his best to look after his younger siblings Meghan, Joe and Tommy.

On August 26, 2010, at the age of 6, Kevin was lost in a tragic accident. While the family and entire community struggled to make sense of this senseless loss, an idea was proposed to establish a foundation to assist other families who struggled with traumatic, life changing events. Thus, The Kevin from Heaven Foundation was born. Since its inception, the KFH Foundation has worked to reach out to individuals and families, by offering both emotional and financial support to those enduring most difficult circumstances.

Why and how do you support Roman?



EITC (Education Improvement) & OSTC (Opportunity Scholarship) Tax Credit programs

What is the tax credit?

The state tax credit program allows businesses (like Customers Bank) and or individuals who pay Pennsylvania taxes to redirect their tax dollars to Roman Catholic High School in the form of tuition assistance and financial aid rather than the state government.

How does it work?

There is a simple, one-page form that you can fill out. From there Roman Catholic and an accredited scholarship organization will handle the rest. You just have to submit your contribution along with a letter designating your gift for Roman Catholic High School within 60 days of approval. The scholarship

organization will send you a letter verifying you have made your contribution and you send that letter to the state. Then the state will issue your tax credit.

How much is the tax credit?

For a one year commitment you will receive a tax credit for 75% of your contribution. For a two year commitment you will receive a tax credit for 90% of your contribution.

What is the money used for?

All monies allocated to Roman Catholic High School are used to provide tuition assistance to families so that students can have a quality Catholic education.

The EITC and OSTC are tremendous tools for Pennsylvania businesses and taxpayers to provide much needed tuition assistance to families who want to send their sons to Roman.

What was your favorite activity while a student at RCHS?

I thoroughly enjoyed being a reporter for The Cahillite, the school newspaper. I concentrated on sports reporting.

What did you do after graduation from Roman?

After graduation, I entered the Military Service, and joined the US Army Air Corps 15th Air Force. I served in Europe and flew 35 missions as a B-24 Ball Turret Gunner. After serving my time in the military, I began my business career as Director of Corporate Policy, RCA Corporation and managed a systems consulting group for General Electric. Following retirement from GE, I was President, Princeton Administrative Systems, Inc., a business systems consultancy. I also served for 28 years on the faculty of Saint Joseph's University, as an Instructor in Sociology. And since retirement, I authored five books: *The Only War I Ever Attended* (2002), *Life as a Guest* (2007), a memoir, *Wartime Cinderella* (2009), – Detailing Roman's Victory in the 1943 Red Cross Hoops Tourney, *Billy Markward and Friends* (2015), and *In Praise Of Good Words* (2018).

What are your fondest memories about your time at Roman?

I treasure my life-long association with wonderful classmates and alumni. As a nation, we were scarcely beginning to emerge from the depths of the Great Depression when I entered Roman in September of 1939, and within a few weeks upon graduation in 1943, my class was headed off for WWII. I vividly remember watching Basketball Coach Billy Markward's classic teaching and coaching my first two years. In my senior year, I savored the remarkable victory Roman had in the Red Cross Championship against West Philadelphia, Penn Charter and the tournament favorite, Lower Merion. Against all odds, and predictions, Roman triumphed! The whole Roman student body held a nighttime march from the Palestra to Broad & Vine to celebrate – we needed police protection after that upset!



Why do you give back to Roman?

I give back because Roman gave so much to me in forming my Catholic faith, in offering a strong academic program, and just as important because of the life-long friendships begun at Broad & Vine.

What did Roman offer to you?

During my time at Roman, I developed an enduring appreciation of my obligations to God, my family and to others. This has affected every stage of my life and has resulted in my lifelong loyalty to the institution.

What is it that makes Roman so unique?

Roman was founded by Philadelphia businessman, Thomas E. Cahill. After 128 years, his remarkable legacy and vision continues to inspire generations of graduates in all vocations and avenues of life, instructing them on the importance of giving back and winning the admiration of so many leaders in our community.

What is your vision for the future of Roman?

Even recognizing the great financial challenges of today, my vision is that Roman continues its mission – thanks in no small part, to continued alumni and community support.

Editor's Note: Joe Kiernan has made it his personal mission to advance the legacy of Coach Billy Markward, who served as RCHS basketball

coach from 1902 to 1942. His efforts led to Markward being inducted into The Philadelphia Sports Hall of Fame in 2015. Subsequently, Joe has assembled a team including: Don DiJulia, retired Saint Joseph's University Athletic Director, Mary Boyle (his daughter) who is a writer and illustrator, and support from the Markward Club, to promote the induction of Markward in the Naismith Memorial Hall of Fame. Markward has recently gained nomination in the category of "Contributor."

All the research and submissions to the Naismith Memorial Hall of Fame are based on Markward's contributions to the game as an outstanding professional player and captain for 12 years beginning in 1893. (That is two years after the game was "founded" by Dr. Naismith.) Markward was an inspirational high school coach at RCHS for 41 years and developed many well-known high school and college coaches of the era. Markward won 20 league championships at Roman in a career in which he consistently declined coaching offers from major colleges and universities. He was nationally recognized in his life-time as the "Dean of High School Coaches."


