As the first diocesan high school in the nation, Roman Catholic High School is home to a faith-community with a unique and distinct history. Spanning over 128 years, Catholic High was built on the foundations of academic rigor, high expectations, and personal responsibility all set within the context of a morals-based school environment.

At Roman, the academic program attempts to broaden young minds,

expand understanding, and create life-long learners. While the tools of education have changed dramatically, the mission of our school has remained constant: forming young men in the truth of the Gospel, ready to take their place in our world.

If you Build it...they will Sing, Draw, Paint and make beautiful Music!

It has been said, "you can't make an omelet without breaking some eggs." Well, in that same vein, you can't build an art center without tearing down some walls!

Construction of the Howard Center for the Arts, actually began with demolition! The pre-existing office complex on the first floor of the building had to be completely removed. All flooring, walls, partitions, and fixtures needed to be dismantled and discarded, as this area will provide the space for an indoor parking facility, with the planned STEM Center (Phase 2 of A Vision of Promise) to be built on the present parking lot of the 1890 building. Providing this parking alternative was paramount.

With the space cleared, footers were dug to accommodate the new elevator, and stair tower. This required cutting through the second floor beams and constructing a large shaft and opening a doorway in the Pearl Street wall for a new exit. The window openings on the Wood Street side of the building

have been enlarged to allow for larger casement windows to provide abundant natural light into the classrooms.

Meanwhile, construction on the second floor classrooms is proceeding according to schedule. The rough plumbing for the bathrooms has been installed, the ductwork for the heating and air conditioning systems is completed and the exhaust hood for the kiln room has been mounted. Additionally, the metal framework for the band room, digital photography studio and art rooms has been completed.

The design of the Black Box Theatre required the removal of existing ceiling and roofing materials and the welding of new beams and supports. The roof was raised approximately 12 feet in this area to accommodate special lighting and acoustical equipment necessary for a versatile theatre. When completed, this intimate theatre will hold around 130 spectators.

Also, the supports for 12 tubular skylights have been welded to the second floor ceiling. This will allow for ample natural light to flood the main corridor of the building.


Topping Off Ceremony

The signature architectural element of the Howard Center will be an all-glass Atrium entrance. This feature, extending over and above the present façade of the building and extending two and a half stories will provide a visual definition and focal point of entry. The Atrium will allow natural lighting to enter the building during the day, and at night, it will be defined by LED lighting. This dramatic statement required extending the existing columns, and the addition of new horizontal beams.

A formal "topping-off" ceremony was held in late December when the last piece of steel for the Atrium was set in place. Student members of the Band, Orchestra, and Chorus, along with representatives of the project architects, managers, and Roman administration, were invited to sign the beam with their name and class year before the beam was hoisted and attached. The beam will remain exposed in the Atrium for generations of musicians, artisans, and guests to view.

As the Howard Center will be ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) compliant, ramps, large doorways, reachable fixtures and easily accessible spaces have been incorporated into the design. The framework for these features has already taken shape as the classroom and corridor walls are being constructed.

While much progress has been made, there is still substantial work to be completed. Large crews from all the major unions (electrical, sheet-metal, masonry, roofing and plumbing) are on sight daily as Erickson, our General Contractor, orchestrates the many phases of construction. Completion of the building is scheduled for early July, with a dedication planned for the early Fall.

Building Bridges through STEM at Broad & Vine

The students were able to view a presentation by the Schuylkill River Development Corporation, have question and answering sessions with AECOM engineers and planners, and network with both AECOM employees and members of the Engineers' Club of Philadelphia. As a follow-up to the event,

Mr. Cameron's senior engineering course took a walking tour of the Schuylkill River green space south of the Art Museum onto the "boardwalk," ending at the South Street Bridge. Joe Syrnick '64, CEO of the Schuylkill River Development Corporation, explained the progress and construction of the landscape, walkway, bridges, and boardwalk through the heart of our city. This event along with a newly introduced engineering elective broadens our STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) offerings for students in preparation for our future STEM Center, which is Phase 2 of our Vision of Promise Campaign.





Brothers for Life

In the autumn of 1902, newly appointed basketball coach at Roman Catholic High School, Billy Markward, informed his team that the Interscholastic League was threatening to ban Roman from league play if they allowed John Lee, an African American player, to remain on the team. Team Captain John Corkery was the first to stand up and speak: "If Johnny Lee doesn't play, then I don't play." Then, one by one, each of the other boys, including Corkery's brother, Maurice, stood and said that they wouldn't play as well. Roman stood with Johnny Lee and the league eventually backed down.

On November 17, 2017, Roman Catholic High School commemorated the 115th anniversary of the legendary 1902-1903 basketball team with a "Brothers For Life" Assembly in the school gym. In attendance were John Lee's grandson, Curtis Cockenberg, Billy Markward's great nephew and current Roman student, Tyler Markward '20, and numerous members of the Corkery family. The Corkery family was formally presented with the "Roman Catholic High School 125 Persons of Distinction Award," and they accepted on behalf of their great uncle, John, who was named one of Roman's 125 "Men of Distinction" in 2015. It was an emotional day for all in attendance, as Father Bongard '77 and Msgr. Frederico Britto '74 gave stirring speeches on the legacy of brotherhood that has been one of the hallmarks of Roman's many traditions, and why it is important, especially today, to stand together as Cahillites against bigotry and hatred. The Corkery family sent the following e-mail after the Assembly:

"Thank you very much for this event. Very emotional day for me and my family. Your eloquently delivered story made us more proud than you can imagine. We went out to lunch and talked about John Corkery's siblings. At Roman today, we spoke about character, integrity, and in what it took for John and Maurie to stand up and support Johnny Lee. Let me show you as it was across the family. His brother Frank, my grandfather, was an electrician who contracted with the city and did all the electrical work on the elevated West Philly section of the El. They had 4 sisters with only one who married. The 3 unmarried sisters lived together and here's how they lived: they always made sure the next door neighbors (struggling, large Irish family) had food on their table by cooking large pots of stews and soups along with baked goods, and explaining the way they accidentally cooked more than they could eat. They did all this while also taking in my father and Aunt Patty to raise them when my grandmother suddenly passed away when Patty was 2, and my father was 3. They raised both as their own which allowed my grandfather to focus on his business. When my father had his stroke in his early 40s (I was about 5) and with my 2 remaining great aunts being elderly, they did the same for me and my siblings. That shows you why John was who he was. Integrity and Character is the legacy they left behind...Maurie made a living, essentially, by buying houses in the neighborhood, renting and/or flipping them all the while making sure he didn't take advantage of people, especially those who were struggling to make ends meet. I recall my great aunts filling up with pride whenever they spoke of John, how wonderful a person he was, and how they felt he was cheated by his life being cut short. They were very close and I like to think they all passed it on to the next generation. I know from a young age, it influenced me

and was always on my mind when raising my kids and I'm making sure that my grandchildren "get it." Thanks once again and stay in contact.

As a first generation American and the oldest son of a family that emigrated from Pakistan, I can tell you opportunity is exactly why my family moved to America. Knowing that your parents gave up everything they knew and loved, in order to provide you and your two younger sisters an opportunity, gives you a reason to be thankful from the very start. It also places a pretty heavy burden on your shoulder to succeed and make those who believe in you proud. My parents taught me that education is vital for a successful life and therefore, I have always strived to excel in school. I was very proud to graduate middle school ranked first in the class. But the biggest decision of my life was looming before me: Where do I choose to enroll for High School?

Since I was from Northeast Philadelphia, there were several very good schools

located only minutes from my home and one, in particular, where almost all my friends were headed. 




