Students engage in collaborative investigations that promote critical and creative thinking, and enjoy educational field trips. Small class sizes, highly qualified special education teachers, and use of assistive technology, permit us to offer data-driven academic instruction for individual student learning profiles. The STEAM program also supports students' social goals through organized recreational sports activities.
