

Searching For and Accessing Follett eBooks in Destiny Quest®

You can search for Follett eBooks in the same way you search for other library materials. To search for eBooks in Destiny Quest by using a Basic or Advanced search:

1. Enter a search term in the **Find** field in a **Basic** search or in the **Show me everything that has...** field in an **Advanced Search**.
2. If you are performing an **Advanced** search and want to limit your search to eBooks, select **Format** from the **Limit my search to...** drop-down list then **Electronic books** from the drop-down list that appears.

To search for all types of materials, including eBooks, do not limit your search to a specific format.

3. Click the **Go!** button.



After performing a search, Follett eBooks display in the search results.



Click on the title link to open the Destiny **Title Details** window.

After clicking the **Read It** button, you have two options for accessing the book:

- You can click the **Open** button to preview or read the book online. You might choose this option if you need the book for short-term use only (e.g., research, previewing a title). You have exclusive use of the eBook as long as you use it actively. If there is no activity for 15 minutes or you close the book, it becomes available to other patrons.

- Click the **Checkout** option to access eBooks for an extended period anywhere you have access to Destiny. You have exclusive use of the eBook for the duration of the loan period or until you return it. If you do not return the book, it is automatically checked in at the end of the loan period.
