



TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN, TRADITIONAL KINDERGARTEN and 1st GRADE ROUNDUP

February 4 to February 15, 2019

LODI UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT'S Transitional and Traditional Kindergarten registration will be **February 4, 2019, until February 15, 2019**, at your attendance area elementary school. Children who will be five (5) on or before September 1, 2019, should register for **Traditional** Kindergarten. Children who will turn five (5) between September 2, 2019, and December 2, 2019, should register for **Transitional** Kindergarten. Children who will be six (6) on or before September 1, 2019, should register for the first grade. (Children already attending a LUSD Traditional Kindergarten are automatically registered for first grade. Children who attend Transitional Kindergarten will be automatically be registered for Traditional Kindergarten at their neighborhood school).

NOTE: A physical examination is required for students entering first grade. An Oral Health Assessment is required for children entering public school for the first time (Kindergarten or 1st Grade).

REGISTRATION/IMMUNIZATION VERIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Parents need to bring the following documents at the time of registration. Your child will not be allowed to attend Kindergarten until all registration documents are provided. Lodi Unified School District maintains a strict NO SHOTS-NO SCHOOL policy.

1. The OFFICIAL birth certificate.
2. Bring address verification to school (utility bill, rent/lease agreement, or bill of sale).
3. Immunization records showing that your child has received all the required immunizations.
This record may be:
 - a. California immunization record or
 - b. Form/letter listing date of immunizations and signed by your doctor

Required immunizations:

1. **POLIO**, 4 DOSES – but 3 doses are enough if at least 1 dose was given on or after the 4th birthday.
2. **DPT/DT/Td** (Diphtheria, Pertussis/Whooping Cough, Tetanus), 5 DOSES – but 4 doses are enough if the 4th dose was given on or after the 4th birthday.
3. **MMR** (Measles, Mumps, and Rubella), 2 DOSES – one dose given on or after the 1st birthday and the 2nd dose is given prior to Kindergarten.
4. **HEPATITIS B**, 3 DOSES – 2nd dose given 1-2 months after 1st dose; 3rd dose given 6 months after 1st dose.
5. **VARICELLA** – 2 DOSE – required or documentation of disease.

IMMUNIZATIONS AVAILABLE AT LOCAL HEALTH CENTERS

INTRADISTRICT OPEN ENROLLMENT POLICY

Lodi Unified School District has an Intradistrict Open Enrollment policy. Parents can apply for enrollment at other district schools and students will be accepted if space is available. The application deadline for Kindergarten Open Enrollment is February 15, 2019. Grades 1-12 open enrollment deadline is February 1, 2019. Attendance area children will be given priority for enrollment. Transportation will not be provided for students on Intradistrict Open Enrollment Agreements.
