- Must be a graduating Dane County High School Senior pursuing a healthcare career
- Must plan to attend a fully accredited institution in the 2019 2020 academic school year
- Must <u>currently attend one of the following high schools</u>: Abundant Day Christian, Belleville, DeForest, Deerfield, Edgewood, Madison Country Day, Madison East, Madison LaFollette, Madison Memorial, Madison West, Malcolm Shabazz, Marshall, McFarland, Middleton, Monona Grove, Mount Horeb, Oregon, Stoughton, Sun Prairie, Verona, Waunakee, Wisconsin Heights, or be a home schooled student.

Attn: UnityPoint Health – Meriter employees, physicians or volunteers ONLY: Applicants are eligible even if they attend a high school outside of Dane County. (The Friends UnityPoint Health-Meriter Scholarship Committee does not award preferential consideration to applications received from Meriter affiliates.)
