

# **Diversified Health Occupations**

## **What is it?**

Diversified Health Occupations (DH0) is a year-long, 1 credit class that is designed to stimulate interest in health science/medical related careers.

## **Who can take it?**

10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders who may be interested in the challenging field of medical and health sciences. Careers include nursing, physicians, occupational therapists, physical therapists, social workers, psychologists, public health careers and many more.

## **Why would you take it?**

To obtain the basic skills and information needed to enter the medical and health science field. This class will help you get an “inside” look at the many different topics and careers that surround our 21<sup>st</sup> century health care system.

Topics include global health care issues, medical and legal ethics, communicable diseases, anatomy and physiology, lifestyle diseases and health science/medical careers.

Diversified Health Occupations (DHO) is also a **prerequisite** for those students who want to be considered for the Honors Nursing Assistant program.
