Review of Previous CC Meeting minutes on 9-26-18:

Go over the proposed budget, goals, and action plans for the SIP for the 2019-2020 school year:

Current goals: Attendance (made for 1st and 2nd term), will make new attendance for next SIP; CTT goal (this is happening monthly), will make new CTT goal for next SIP; DIBELS goal (progressing as expected), will make new DIBELS goal for next SIP; Raising SAGE MATH proficiency (progressing, but w/RISE testing), will renew goal for next SIP, but possibly include CRTs as well as RISE testing; LEAN/curriculum mapping goal (progressing as expected), will need to choose a new goal for next year as this comes to conclusion this year.

--Projected Trustlands for 2019-2020= \$54,279 (\$5000 increase) with carryover of \$48 this year in Trustlands. This money will be spent in 3 major areas next year with the biggest chunk going to pay salaries for Math and ELA instructional aides (4 total) to help with our Math and ELA SIP goals for next year, another big piece will be the audio enhancement systems we are purchasing over three years with matching funds from the district for our \$5000 input each year to help meet our ELA/Math SIP goals for next year, and the third large chunk will go toward improving technology with updates for projectors, digital curriculum (such as Go Math or REFLEX math, etc).

Learning First Planning day is scheduled for March 25th, 2019.
