Elementary Reading Expo - March 26th - 2.15-4.00pm

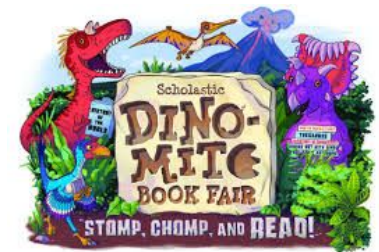
Theme: Reading Rocks!
