



De La Salle Summer Hybrid Biology Survey Course: Summer 2019

De La Salle will be offering a credit recovery Hybrid Biology Survey course this summer for students who received a “D” or “F” in their Biology course. Students must sign up for the specific semester they are looking to remediate. **This course will run from June 17 - July 22 (5 weeks). Final grades will be issued the week July 29th.**

Students must attend laboratory time on Wednesdays on the DLS Campus:

- **Semester 1 lab is from 9:00 AM – 10:30 AM.**
- **Semester 2 lab is from 10:45 AM – 12:15 PM.**

Course availability subject to adequate enrollment.

This lab time is mandatory for UC/NCAA approval and there are no exceptions. Since the summer make up courses are short in duration, lab attendance is required. Therefore, students may not be able to make up missed labs, and those missed labs will result in a zero.

The lab dates are: June 19th, July 10th, July 17th. Please plan accordingly.

There will be a virtual lab on Wednesday, June 26th and July 3rd. (These are done on Schoology- do not report to campus)

The price for this course will be \$625 per semester enrollment (\$1,250 full course). This includes access to Schoology, textbook, class materials, and lab materials.

Please note:

As a hybrid course, students will need to be self-disciplined and complete work online on their own during the week with the exception of the lab day (Wednesday). All students must be present for labs. Each unit will close on Friday. Students should plan their week accordingly to complete coursework and lab reports.



Course Breakdown:

Each week will consist of 1 Unit (two major topics each week; including labs for each topic every Wednesday). Students will have access to the material starting on Monday and should complete all work by the Friday of that week. Lab experiments are completed on Wednesday and lab reports are due the following Monday (**the lab for week 5 will be due on Mon. July 22nd**). **Late work will NOT be accepted.**

Weekly Breakdown:

Monday: Unit available/open to students on Schoology. Students complete coursework/homework on Schoology.

Tuesday: Students complete coursework/homework on Schoology.

Wednesday: Students must report to De La Salle for lab work.

S1 = 9 AM – 10:30 AM / S2 = 10:45 AM – 12:15PM

Thursday: Students complete coursework/homework on Schoology and should start writing lab reports

Friday: Students must have all coursework/homework completed on Schoology. Lab reports must be finished and submitted before the following Monday by 9:00 AM.

Late work will NOT be accepted.

Lab Breakdown:

Semester 1: 9:00 AM - 10:30 AM: Meet in Room 511. Complete lab

Semester 2: 10:45 AM - 12:15 PM: Meet in Room 511. Complete lab

Please note: Mrs. Howett will not be on campus except for Wednesday lab period. All other communication with her should be done through Schoology.

Student Dress Code for Labs:

Students must adhere to normal De La Salle dress code policies. Closed toe shoes must be worn for safety purposes. Please refer to the student handbook for specific guidelines.

Materials Needed:

- Notebook for Lab work
- Students are strongly encouraged to use their own laptop. De La Salle will have a limited amount of laptops available during the summer and they are only available for on campus use.
- Textbook (Provided by DLS)

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Rules and Regulations:

Students will be expected to adhere to all De La Salle student policies while enrolled in the online course. Proper behavior and language is expected while interacting with the teacher and other students through the learning management system. While on campus for the lab period students are expected to adhere to the student behavior policies outlined in the student handbook. This extends to the proper respect and behavior toward De La Salle property (textbook, lab room, desks, chairs, etc.) and must follow Mrs. Howett's instructions at all times in the lab. Students who are not adhering to proper behavioral guidelines will be removed from the program without a refund of tuition and will be given no credit for the course.
