Proposals will be submitted only on the forms provided, will be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked with the name of the bidder, the title of the work and must be delivered to the Purchasing Department, Troy School District, 4400 Livernois, Troy, Michigan 48089, no later than 2 p.m., Tuesday, July 15, 2014, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately thereafter. Bid proposals received after this time will not be considered or accepted. Oral, telephone, fax or electronic mail bids are invalid and will not receive consideration. Submit one original and one copy.
- 3. Proposals will be made in conformity with all the conditions set forth in the specifications. All items of furniture and equipment must conform to the specifications.

All shipments will be F.O.B. delivered, Troy School District, to each specific school location listed on the requirements and specifications.

FIRM PRICING

The successful bidder(s) will hold bid prices firm for all purchase orders placed through August, 2015 or for a period of approximately one full year.

WARRANTY

All material and equipment will be guaranteed to be free from defects in both workmanship and materials for no less than one year from date of receipt/installation. If manufacturer warranty exceeds this minimum requirement, the manufacturer warranty will prevail. Any item(s) found to be defective will be replaced or repaired within seven working days at Vendor(s) expense.

PAYMENTS

Payment in full will be due and payable within thirty days after delivery, providing all goods are approved and accepted by the Board of Education and the contract having been fully performed.
