PROPOSALS

- 1. The Troy School District will receive firm, sealed bids for all labor, materials, equipment and other services to relocate a Playground Structures at Wass and Troy Elementary Schools, in accordance with the attached specifications.
- 2. Proposals will be submitted only on the forms provided, will be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked with the name of the bidder, the title of the work and must be delivered to the Purchasing Department, Troy School District, 1140 Rankin, Troy, Michigan 48083, no later than 2 p.m., Tuesday, June 3, 2014, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately thereafter. Bid proposals received after this time will not be considered or accepted. Oral, telephone, fax or electronic mail bids are invalid and will not receive consideration. Submit one original and one copy.
- 3. Proposals will be made in conformity with all the conditions set forth in the specifications. All items of furniture and equipment must conform to the specifications.
- 4. A pre-proposal conference has been scheduled for 4:00 p.m., Thursday, May 22, 2014, at Wass Elementary, 2340 Willard Dr., Troy, MI 48085 and will continue at Troy Union Elementary, 1340 East Square Lake Rd, Troy, MI 48085. - 7. The successful bidder and its subordinate parties shall comply with the Prevailing Wage Requirements for all work as required by the State of Michigan Public Act 166 Dated 1965 As Amended.
- 8. A completed Familial Disclosure and an Iran Economic Sanctions form must be included with each proposal submitted or the proposal will not be accepted, please note these forms must be notarized.

SCOPE

Provide all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to relocate two Elementary School Playground Structures based on CSPC and ADA guidelines, for Troy School District.

TIMING

Company must begin approximately June 18, 2014 and must have the project completed August 10, 2014.

CONTRACT AWARD

The contract will be awarded in the form of PURCHASE ORDERS mailed to the Vendor(s) selected. It is the intent to award the bid on June 17, 2014 at the regular monthly meeting of the Board of Education.

WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

Any bidder may withdraw their bid at any time prior to the scheduled time for receipt of bids. No proposal may be withdrawn until after 45 days after bid opening

INSURANCE

Satisfactory Workers' Compensation coverage of at least \$2,000,000.00 and General Liability and Property Damage Insurance of at least \$2,000,000.00 per occurrence and \$3,000,000.00 in Aggregate must be carried and paid for by the contractor(s) who undertakes the work on this contract. Insurance coverage must also include automobile insurance of at least \$2,000,000.00. Bid number and Troy School District as additional insured must be noted on the insurance certificate. Certificate holder will be Troy Schools.

BID GUARANTEE

Bidders must submit with their proposal a bid bond or certified check for not less than five percent of the bid. Failure to include a five percent bid guarantee will result in the rejection of your bid.

GUARANTEE BONDS

Prior to the issuance of a purchase order authorizing commencement of this project, and in all cases before beginning work under the contract, the Vendor/Contractor(s) selected will qualify for, sign and deliver to the Purchasing Office, an executed performance bond and executed labor and materials payment bond secured by the surety company. Each bond will be in the amount of 100 percent of the contract. Troy Schools requires that the bonding companies be limited to those listed on the U.S. Department of Treasury Circular 570, and must be licensed in the State of Michigan. The U.S. Department of Treasury Circular 570 can be viewed at the following web site: http://www.fms.treas.gov/c570/c570.html. Certificates of such insurance and bonds will be filed with the Purchasing Office within five working days of notification of bid award and before any work begins.

DELIVERY

All shipments will be F.O.B. delivered, Troy School District, Wass Elementary, 2340 Willard Dr., Troy, MI 48085 and Troy Union Elementary, 1340 East Square Lake Road, Troy, MI 48085.

WARRANTY

All material and equipment will be guaranteed to be free from defects in both workmanship and materials for no less than one year from date of receipt/installation. If manufacturer warranty exceeds this minimum requirement, the manufacturer warranty will prevail. Any item(s) found to be defective will be replaced or repaired within seven working days at Vendor(s) expense.

PERMITS

All necessary permits, tests, inspections and approvals will be procured by the contractor(s) and will be included in the proposal.

PAYMENTS

Payment in full will be due and payable within thirty days after delivery, providing all goods are approved and accepted by the Board of Education and the contract having been fully performed.

Playground Structures Removal & Re-Installation Specifications

Part 1 – General

1.01 WORK SCOPE

- A. Provide labor, materials, and equipment necessary to re-install Play Structure based on CSPC and ADA guidelines. Pictures of units are below for the following two Elementary School Playground Sites:
 - Wass Elementary School
 2340 Willard Troy, Michigan 48085
 - Troy Union Elementary School 1340 East Square Lake Road – Troy, Michigan 48085
- B. Installer must be certified and/or authorized by manufacturer to install the Composite Structure (Landscape Structures, Inc.)
- C. Prep new location for play structure, excavate spoils and remove from site. Disposal of excavated spoils must comply with all Local and State regulations.
- D. Repair any damaged area caused by heavy equipment. Repair all turf surface areas affected by this project. Top-dress damage area; rake out debris and stones, seed and straw.
- E. Install drainage system to prevent flooding and promote proper drainage to minimize decay of Loose-Fill Surface material inside the play structure border. Bid package must outline type of drain tile used, fill, number of layers of Geotex felt used, depth of border and if a drywell system is required.
- F. Smart Tech Border or equal (no wood products allowed). Border must be installed so it does not create a trip hazard at any point around the entire unit.
- G. Install Slide Mats (3'by 4' by 2" thick) at the base of each slide (2).

1.02 SCHEDULING

- A. The completion date for the project is **15 August 2014**. Project will be ready to start on the day the bid is approved by the Troy School District Board of Education.
- B. Must provide a timeline report outlining the removal and installation from start to finish (estimated based on normal conditions).
- C. Pre-bid will be held on May 22, 2014 at 4:00pm, starting location, Wass Elementary School, 2340 Willard, Troy, Michigan 48085, and continuing at Troy Union Elementary, 1340 East Square Lake Rd, Troy, MI 48085.

Part 2 – Material

2.01 MATERIALS

- A. Loose-Fill Surface material depth must comply with CPSC guidelines.
- B. Sample (s) of each product must be part of the bid package and in compliance with CPSC guidelines.
- C. Provide MSDS for products that are classified as a potential hazard to workforce, district employees or the community.
- D. Disposal of packing material is the responsibility of the installer, not Troy School District. Materials should be disposed of in accordance with Local and State guidelines.

Part 3 - Execution

3.01 INSPECTION

A. Once the installation is completed the company rep will be required to walk the site with the Kenneth D. Miller, Executive Director Facilities and Operations for final approval.

3.02 <u>SAFETY GUIDELINES</u>

- A. It is recommended that you walk the site to verify scope of work. During normal school hours all bidders will be require to check in with the main office at each of the sites before entering school playground areas.
- B. Must maintain a safety zone around areas being serviced at all times.
- C. You will be required to check with the Executive Director prior to the start of this project for approval to store or create a staging area for heavy equipment, trailers and materials.

3.03 QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. Work areas must be kept safe, clean and organized at all times.
- B. Contractor will be responsible for any and all damage caused during the installation process.

Note: Parts of play structure #1 for Wass Elementary will not be re-installed as required by the principal due to a number of injuries. This will be reviewed during the pre-bid meeting. The District will also be requesting an alternate bid on replacement swing sets for a couple of the "A Frame" units that are no longer in compliance with CPSC guidelines.

Informational Sheet: Prevailing Wages on State Projects

REQUIREMENTS OF THE PREVAILING WAGES ON STATE PROJECTS ACT, PUBLIC ACT 166 OF 1965

The State of Michigan determines prevailing rates pursuant to the Prevailing Wages on State Projects Act, Public Act 166 of 1965, as amended. The purpose of establishing prevailing rates is to provide minimum rates of pay that must be paid to workers on construction projects for which the state or a school district is the contracting agent and which is financed or financially supported by the state. By law, prevailing rates are compiled from the rates contained in collectively bargained agreements which cover the locations of the state projects. The official prevailing rate schedule provides an hourly rate which includes wage and fringe benefit totals for designated construction mechanic classifications. The overtime rates also include wage and fringe benefit totals. Please pay special attention to the overtime and premium pay requirements. Prevailing wage is satisfied when wages plus fringe benefits paid to a worker are equal to or greater than the required rate.

State of Michigan responsibilities under the law:

• The department establishes the prevailing rate for each classification of construction mechanic *requested by a contracting agent* prior to contracts being let out for bid on a state project.

Contracting agent responsibilities under the law:

- If a contract is not awarded or construction does not start within 90 days of the date of the issuance of rates, a redetermination of rates must be requested by the contracting agent.
- Rates for classifications needed but not provided on the Prevailing Rate Schedule, *must* be obtained *prior* to contracts being let out for bid on a state project.
- The contracting agent, by written notice to the contractor and the sureties of the contractor known to the contracting
 agent, may terminate the contractor's right to proceed with that part of the contract, for which less than the prevailing
 rates have been or will be paid, and may proceed to complete the contract by separate agreement with another
 contractor or otherwise, and the original contractor and his sureties shall be liable to the contracting agent for any
 excess costs occasioned thereby.

Contractor responsibilities under the law:

- Every contractor and subcontractor shall keep posted on the construction site, in a conspicuous place, a copy of all prevailing rates prescribed in a contract.
- Every contractor and subcontractor shall keep an accurate record showing the name and occupation of and the actual
 wages and benefits paid to each construction mechanic employed by him in connection including certified payroll, as
 used in the industry, with said contract. This record shall be available for reasonable inspection by the contracting
 agent or the department.
- Each contractor or subcontractor is separately liable for the payment of the prevailing rate to its employees.
- The prime contractor is responsible for advising all subcontractors of the requirement to pay the prevailing rate prior to commencement of work.
- The prime contractor is secondarily liable for payment of prevailing rates that are not paid by a subcontractor.
- A construction mechanic *shall only* be paid the apprentice rate if registered with the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training and the rate is included in the contract.

Enforcement:

A person who has information of an alleged prevailing wage violation on a state project may file a complaint with the State of Michigan. The department will investigate and attempt to resolve the complaint informally. During the course of an investigation, if the requested records and posting certification are not made available in compliance with Section 5 of Act 166, the investigation will be concluded and a referral to the Office of Attorney General for civil action will be made. The Office of Attorney General will pursue costs and fees associated with a lawsuit if filing is necessary to obtain records.

Informational Sheet: Prevailing Wages on State Projects

General Information Regarding Fringe Benefits

Certain fringe benefits **may** be credited toward the payment of the Prevailing Wage Rate:

- If a fringe benefit is paid directly to a construction mechanic
- o If a fringe benefit contribution or payment is made on behalf of a construction mechanic
- If a fringe benefit, which may be provided to a construction mechanic, is pursuant to a written contract or policy
- o If a fringe benefit is paid into a fund, for a construction mechanic

When a fringe benefit is not paid by an hourly rate, the hourly credit will be calculated based on the annual value of the fringe benefit divided by 2080 hours per year (52 weeks @ 40 hours per week).

The following is an example of the types of fringe benefits allowed and how an hourly credit is calculated:

Vacation Dental insurance Vision insurance Health insurance Life insurance Tuition Bonus 401k Employer Contribution	40 hours X \$14.00 per hour = \$560/2080 = \$31.07 monthly premium X 12 mos. = \$372.84 /2080 = \$5.38 monthly premium X 12 mos. = \$64.56/2080 = \$230.00 monthly premium X 12 mos. = \$2,760.00/2080 = \$27.04 monthly premium X 12 mos. = \$324.48/2080 = \$500.00 annual cost/2080 = 4 quarterly bonus/year x \$250 = \$1000.00/2080 = \$2000.00 total annual contribution/2080 =	\$.27 \$.18 \$.03 \$1.33 \$.16 \$.24 \$.48 \$.96
Total Hourly Credit		\$3.65

Other examples of the types of fringe benefits allowed:

- Sick pay
- Holiday pay
- Accidental Death & Dismemberment insurance premiums

The following are examples of items that **will not** be credited toward the payment of the Prevailing Wage Rate

- Legally required payments, such as:
 - Unemployment Insurance payments
 - Workers' Compensation Insurance payments
 - FICA (Social Security contributions, Medicare contributions)
- Reimbursable expenses, such as:
 - Clothing allowance or reimbursement
 - Uniform allowance or reimbursement
 - Gas allowance or reimbursement
 - Travel time or payment
 - Meals or lodging allowance or reimbursement
 - Per diem allowance or payment
- Other payments to or on behalf of a construction mechanic that are not wages or fringe benefits, such as:
 - Industry advancement funds
 - Financial or material loans

OVERTIME PROVISIONS for MICHIGAN PREVAILING WAGE RATE COMMERCIAL SCHEDULE

 Overtime is represented as a nine character code. Each character represents a certain period of time after the first 8 hours Monday thru Friday.

	Monday thru Friday	Saturday	Sunday & Holidays	Four 10s
First 8 Hours		4		
9th Hour	1	5	8	
10th Hour	2	6		9
Over 10 hours	3	7		

Overtime for Monday thru Friday after 8 hours:

the 1st character is for time worked in the 9th hour (8.1 - 9 hours)

the 2nd character is for time worked in the 10th hour (9.1 - 10 hours)

the 3rd character is for time worked beyond the 10th hour (10.1 and beyond)

Overtime on Saturday:

the 4th character is for time worked in the first 8 hours on Saturday (0 - 8 hours)

the 5th character is for time worked in the 9th hour on Saturday (8.1 - 9 hours)

the 6th character is for time worked in the 10th hour (9.1 - 10 hours)

the 7th character is for time worked beyond the 10th hour (10.01 and beyond)

Overtime on Sundays & Holidays

The 8th character is for time worked on Sunday or on a holiday

Four Ten Hour Days

The 9th character indicates if an optional 4-day 10-hour per day workweek can be worked **between Monday and Friday** without paying overtime after 8 hours worked, unless otherwise noted in the rate schedule. To utilize
a 4 ten workweek, notice is required from the employer to employee prior to the start of work on the project.

- 2. Overtime Indicators Used in the Overtime Provision:
 - H means TIME AND ONE-HALF due
 - X means TIME AND ONE-HALF due after 40 HOURS worked
 - D means DOUBLE PAY due
 - Y means YES an optional 4-day 10-hour per day workweek can be worked without paying overtime after 8 hours worked
 - N means NO an optional 4-day 10-hour per day workweek *can not* be worked without paying overtime after 8 hours worked

3. EXAMPLES:

HHHHHHDN - This example shows that the 1½ rate must be used for time worked after 8 hours Monday thru Friday *(characters 1 - 3);* for all hours worked on Saturday, 1½ rate is due *(characters 4 - 7).* Work done on Sundays or holidays must be paid double time *(character 8).* The N *(character 9)* indicates that 4 ten-hour days is not an acceptable workweek at regular pay.

XXXHHHHDY - This example shows that the $1\frac{1}{2}$ rate must be used for time worked after 40 hours are worked Monday thru Friday (*characters 1-3*); for hours worked on Saturday, $1\frac{1}{2}$ rate is due (*characters 4 - 7*). Work done on Sundays or holidays must be paid double time (*character 8*). The Y (*character 9*) indicates that 4 ten-hour days is an acceptable alternative workweek.

UNDERGROUND ENGINEERS

CLASS I

Backfiller Tamper, Backhoe, Batch Plant Operator, Clam-Shell, Concrete Paver (2 drums or larger), Conveyor Loader (Euclid type), Crane (crawler, truck type or pile driving), Dozer, Dragline, Elevating Grader, End Loader, Gradall (and similar type machine), Grader, Power Shovel, Roller (asphalt), Scraper (self propelled or tractor drawn), Side Broom Tractor (type D-4 or larger), Slope Paver, Trencher (over 8' digging capacity), Well Drilling Rig, Mechanic, Slip Form Paver, Hydro Excavator.

CLASS II

Boom Truck (power swing type boom), Crusher, Hoist, Pump (1 or more 6" discharge or larger gas or diesel powered by generator of 300 amps or more, inclusive of generator), Side Boom Tractor (smaller than type D-4 or equivalent), Tractor (pneu-tired, other than backhoe or front end loader), Trencher (8' digging capacity and smaller), Vac Truck.

CLASS III

Air Compressors (600 cfm or larger), Air Compressors (2 or more less than 600 cfm), Boom Truck (non-swinging, non-powered type boom), Concrete Breaker (self-propelled or truck mounted, includes compressor), Concrete Paver (1 drum, ½ yard or larger), Elevator (other than passenger), Maintenance Man, Mechanic Helper, Pump (2 or more 4" up to 6" discharge, gas or diesel powered, excluding submersible pump), Pumpcrete Machine (and similar equipment), Wagon Drill Machine, Welding Machine or Generator (2 or more 300 amp or larger, gas or diesel powered).

CLASS IV

Boiler, Concrete Saw (40HP or over), Curing Machine (self-propelled), Farm Tractor (w/attachment), Finishing Machine (concrete), Firemen, Hydraulic Pipe Pushing Machine, Mulching Equipment, Oiler (2 or more up to 4", exclude submersible), Pumps (2 or more up to 4" discharge if used 3 hrs or more a day-gas or diesel powered, excluding submersible pumps), Roller (other than asphalt), Stump Remover, Vibrating Compaction Equipment (6' wide or over), Trencher (service) Sweeper (Wayne type and similar equipment), Water Wagon, Extend-a-Boom Forklift.
