Part 1 – General

1.01 WORK SCOPE

- Provide labor, materials and equipment necessary to remove the existing dump body and replace with a Rugby Stainless Steel 8 Feet dump body or equal. See specifications listed below.
- Installer must be certified and/or authorized by manufacturer to install the new dump body.
- The disposal of old dump body, hoist, framework and fluids must comply with all Local and State regulations. The district will not be responsible for the removal, disposal or cleanup of waste and/or debris associated with the project.
- Repair damaged areas affected by installation.

1.02 SCHEDULING

- A. The projected completion date is **December 1, 2010**. Start date will be determined based on final approved by the Troy School District Board of Education.
- B. Must provide a timeline report outlining the delivery of materials, demo/installation from start to finish (estimated based on normal conditions) and return date.
- C. Must provide documentation that outlines the scope of work to be completed.

Part 2 – Material Specifications

2.01 MATERIALS – Dump Body

- A. See attached specifications.
- B. Must provide a complete set of specifications as part of the bid package for any alternate products that are equal to the specification listed below.
- C. Provide MSDS for products (fluids) that are classified as a potential hazard to workforce, district employees or the community.
 - Rugby Stainless Steel 8' dump body with 3/16" AR400 one piece cross member-less floor. Natural finish (no paint).
 - 304 #4 polished stainless steel sides, front and tailgate (no exceptions)
 - 14" side height no vertical braces with dirt shedding top rail
 - 24" front and tailgate with stainless steel e-z latch tailgate

- Tailgate must have minimum 1-1/4" diameter solid stainless steel top and 1" bottom hinge pins. (no exceptions) ¼" cab shield 304 stainless polished 7" I-Beam longsills
- LED marker lights / stop, turn and tail lights
- NTEA class 20 hoist
- Cylinder to have a minimum 5" bore, 16" stroke and 2" diameter rod. Double acting power up and power down (no exceptions) 9 ton capacity

2.02 Hydraulic System

- A. Remove old system and install new system as specified:
- Engine driven clutch pump hydraulics to operate dump, spreader and plow C.W Mills mounting kit with serpentine belt system.
 - Commercial Inertech pump delivers 17 g.p.m @ 1600 rpm
 - 12 volt electric 125 ft. lb. clutch, Heavy-Duty sealed bearing On/off switch in dash.
 - Gresen V-20-1 12volt solenoid to operate single stack double acting valve with cylinder port relief and power beyond, adjustable flow divider for fine tuning of flow to either auger or spinner.
 - Spreader control valve mounted on console for adjustment of auger and spinner
 - Side mount 25 gallon hydraulic oil tank with sight/temp. gauge
 - Return line filter assembly with (2) two ball valves
 - Hydraulic hoses and Stainless Steel quick-disconnects with dust caps at rear for truck and spreader.

Note: Install Troy School District supplied Stainless Steel under tailgate salt spreader

2.03 Strobe Lights

- A. New installation:
- (4) four LED oval strobe light system
 - (2) Two mounted in rear post below stop, turn and tail lights.
 - (2) Two mounted in front of cab shield
- B. All wires are to be run into a junction box and direct to light and power source (no splices)

2.04 Tarp System

- A. New installation:
- Donovan manual 200x Tarp system
 - Hand crank control
 - 14' Black mesh tarp cover
 - Rear cross bar

Part 3 – Execution

3.01 INSPECTION

- A. Once the installation is completed, the company rep will be required to review the installation with the Director of Operations (Kenneth D. Miller) for final approval.

3.02 SAFETY GUIDELINES

- A. It is recommended that you inspect the vehicle to verify scope of work. During normal school hours all bidders will be required to check in with the main office at Maintenance & Operations – 1140 Rankin, Troy 48083 before entering the school district property. You are required setup an appointment with the Director of Operations to inspect the vehicle.

3.03 QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. Contractor will be responsible for any and all damage caused during the removal and/or installation process.
