

Summer At The Academy

Summer At The Academy was launched thirty-one years ago and has grown into one of the most successful summer programs in the Southwest. Each year more than 1400 boys and girls from South Texas and beyond attend a diverse array of over 300 classes taught by more than seventy of the area's top teachers, coaches and artisans. Summer At The Academy, an eight-week enrichment program for boys and girls ages four and older, provides excellent opportunities to create, learn, explore and have fun. Listed below is general information about our program. We anticipate the return of our former students and look forward to welcoming newcomers to our campus. Please call us if you have any questions.

ENRICHMENT COURSES

Week-long enrichment courses will be offered in the mornings from 9:00–11:30 AM and in the afternoons from 12:30-3:00 PM. Enrollment in each class is limited and will vary according to age group or topic.

Classrooms will be open 15 minutes prior to and following class. Students who arrive early or who are not picked up on time will be placed in our Wildcat Alley facility, and parents will be charged \$15.00 for each quarter-hour or part thereof. In order to ensure each child's safety, parents are asked to park and escort their children to the first day of class and from class each day.

SECURITY/SAFETY FIRST

Our campus is staffed with trained and certified personnel who monitor access to the campus.

We have on duty from 7:30 AM – 6:00 PM a RN/LVN who administers prescribed medication and responds to medical emergencies. A physician is on-call at all times for medical service and to advise health service personnel on all first aid and nursing services provided by the camp.

LUNCH/BROWN BAG

Hot Lunch is a nutritious meal served in our Dining Hall. Menu is posted on our website. Regrettably we cannot accommodate special dietary requirements. Hot Lunch is included in Kids Place fees. **Brown Bag participants bring their own lunch & drink.** They eat in a separate air-conditioned location. Regrettably we cannot guarantee an allergy-free environment.

KIDS' PLACE

Kids' Place is for boys and girls ages 4-12 who are enrolled in **both** AM and PM enrichment classes. Full day Kid's Place includes mornings from 7:30-9:00AM, NoonCare/Lunch 11:30-12:30 and afternoons from 3:00-6:00 PM. Kids' Place provides creative and fun activities in a well-supervised and safe setting. Students are escorted to lunch and enrichment classes by staff.

Children are grouped according to their age and age groups may vary, dependent upon weekly enrollment. Please note: after 6:00 PM, there will be a late fee of \$15/quarter hour or part thereof.

REGISTRATION

Early registration is advised as all classes and Kids' Place have a limited enrollment and many classes fill early. Registration begins Monday, March 18, 2019. Online, mail, and walk-in registrations are accepted. Payment in full is made at the time of registration. A \$25 fee will be charged for returned checks.

The registration fee is \$15 per student, per year. This fee is not refundable. Registration for all enrichment courses and Kids' Place will close at 1:00 PM the Wednesday prior to the start of the class (except for Week 6 – Monday 1:00PM). Schedules are set at 1:00 PM the Wednesday prior to the start of the class (except for Week 6 – Monday 1:00 PM). No class changes or tuition transfers can be made after this time.

CANCELLATION

A \$50 cancellation fee will be charged for each week that classes are cancelled. Registration may be cancelled and the tuition refunded (minus the cancellation fee) four weeks prior to the beginning of the class. **No refunds will be given with less than four weeks notice.** If a class is cancelled by The Academy due to conditions beyond our control (e.g., weather, fire, etc), no refunds will be given and the tuition is not transferable to another class. **For information when such situations occur, please check our website (www.sa-academy.org) and/or our phone greeting/message (733-7331), as well as local TV and radio stations.** If a class is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, the tuition may be transferred to another class or refunded in full. Parents will be notified of such cancellations the week prior to the class. Each time a confirmed class is changed, a \$15 fee will be charged. There are no refunds or rescheduling due to absences.

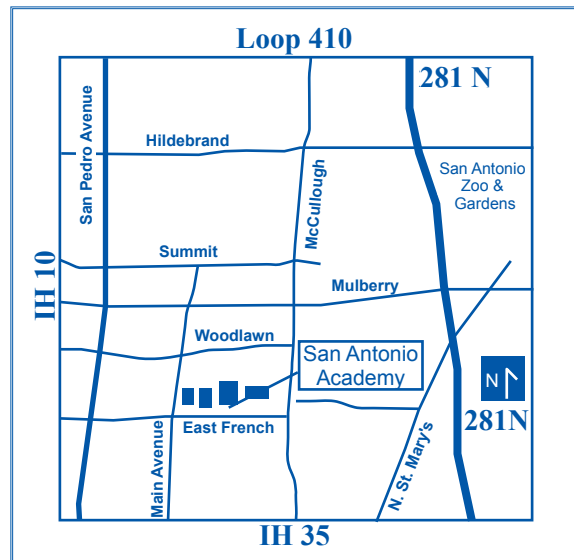
CAMPUS

ON THE COVER

The Thomas H. Franklin House, on the campus of The San Antonio Academy, serves as a lovely gateway to the Monte Vista Historical District. It is listed on the national Register of Historic Places and is an outstanding example of 19th century shingle style architecture.

The house was built in 1891 by Thomas Franklin, a renowned San Antonio lawyer, and was restored through the generous efforts of San Antonio Conservation Society.
