NEW! Security Information for Parents and Visitors to GHS

All visitors to GHS will now have their driver's license scanned in a system called "RAPTOR". This system checks the individual for criminal warrants, outstanding court orders that involve injury to children, and scans the national database of sex-offenders. Once cleared through the system, visitors are given a pass to be worn that portrays their picture and the location in the school being visited. **Please, when checking in make sure to have your driver's license and license plate number available.**

New Lunch Block Policy: Students and staff have raised ongoing concerns that the library is not conducive to academic work during lunch block in particular, essentially becoming "another Student Center". Consequently, the Media Staff, with input from students and Administration, have adopted a new lunch block policy to ensure that the library is a welcoming place for the GHS Community to work and collaborate.

Effective **Monday. March 11**, the lunch block will become **Quiet Study Only**. Food will still be permitted in the library throughout the day but during lunch block, students must remain seated and converse quietly, whether they are eating or not. Otherwise they will be directed back to the Student Center for the remainder of lunch block. Continued violations of the policy will result in referrals to the assistant deans.
