

Cathedral High School Head Varsity Girls Basketball Coach

SUMMARY

Directs and coordinates the planning, organizing, and coaching of the Cathedral High School women's basketball team.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Provides leadership and instruction in the personal and athletic development of student athletes at Cathedral High School.
- Directs and coordinates the activities of the basketball; ensures compliance with IHSAA policies and regulations.
- Directs the basketball staff in the preparation of analyses of opponent teams; analyzes game statistics and tactical data of opponents, and prepares game plans accordingly.
- Counsels team members in academic, disciplinary and personal matters; consults with school administration and faculty for resolution of problems as required.
- Studies, evaluates, and implements innovations in basketball strategy and equipment.
- Represents the Cathedral High School athletic department in professional, civic, charity, and alumni events.
- Perform other related duties incidental to the work described herein.
- Prepares and organizes practice sessions, game preparation for competition and off-season training; recommends and prepares all schedules for home tournaments and non-conference games to the Athletic Director; engages in regular consultation with athletic training and other department sports medicine personnel to maximize the safety and wellness of student-athletes, and demonstrates concern for the overall welfare of students at all times; responsible for monitoring and supporting the student-athletes academic progress in consultation and coordination with the Academic Support Services Director; organizes and directs the coaching staff to carry out the goals and objectives of the women's basketball program; prepares and participates in camps and clinics as needed; provides general advising, mentoring and support to student-athletes; role models and engages in ethical decision-making and outstanding sportsmanship; demonstrates through actions and communicates a respect for diversity and cross-cultural differences; perform other duties as required.
