Under Approval of the Agenda, Board Member David Wortman made a motion to approve the agenda. Board Member Donald Hayes seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Approval of the
Agenda

Superintendent Dr. Tim Markley and Assistant Superintendent of Operations Eddie Anderson presented the Guiding Principles. Board Member David Wortman stated that the principles should be bulleted instead of in numerical order. The entire Board agreed and requested the change.

Guiding Principles

Superintendent Dr. Tim Markley and Assistant Superintendent of Operations Eddie Anderson reviewed the elementary, middle and high school redistricting timelines. The Board directed Mr. Anderson to look at all of the district lines when preparing the proposed map(s). The Board also directed Mr. Anderson to accelerate the timelines. Elementary map(s) should be available to the public in October or November of this year. In addition, there should be eight months allotted for public input. A final vote on the elementary school map will take place on August 2019. Middle and high school maps will be reviewed in July and available to the public shortly after the July Redistricting Work Session. A final vote on the middle and high school maps will take place on November 6, 2018, during the Regular Meeting of the Board. The Board also stated that they would honor Senior privilege. In addition, students enrolled in a Signature Programs may stay in the programs.




