
Board Member Bruce Shell asked, SEA Tech is drawing from which schools? Mr. Anderson will answer that question at the next Redistricting Work Session


There was a suggestion to keep study areas 160, 183, 184, 185, 183A at Williston Middle School and to enlarge the downtown satellites.
