Review of Administrative Goals & Anticipated Trust Land Funding

- Goal 1: Decrease the number of students below proficient on the SRI report from 16.5% to 14.5%
- Goal 2: Maintain number of students on track for graduation at 95% and increase 9th grade career readiness course enrollment
- Goal 3: Increase the number of students who believe they have “personally been rewarded for good behavior” on the School Climate Survey from 28.7% to 33.7%. And increase the percentage of learners who are monitoring and reflecting on their own progress.
