Greetings from NFA. I hope all is well with your family. Please be advised of the following important informational items and dates of distinction.

### **March 27 – SAT Testing for Grade 11 Students**

As per Connecticut State Department of Education requirements, NFA will administer the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) to all 11th-grade students, Wednesday, March 27.

Students will be e-mailed their test room location by Sunday, March 24. On test day, it's very important that students be on time for school and bring with them their calculator and pencils.

To find more information from the Connecticut State Department of Education about the School Day SAT, check our website at MyNFA>Parents. Click on "2018-19 SAT School Day Information." SAT preparation materials have been distributed and reviewed in class with students. Students can also review for the test on Khan Academy by accessing the link on their MyNFA>Student Portal Dashboard.

**The testing requires an alternative schedule on March 27 for some students and a day off from school for others. The plan for each grade level is listed below:**

- Grade 9–No School for Students/Professional Development for Cranston House faculty and staff. For ninth-graders, this day compensates for the first day of school in September
- Grade 10–School in Session/Core classes, including English, Science, Mathematics, Civics, and World Language will be held with modifications to class locations due to testing. Students will receive a special schedule for the day.
- Grade 11–School in Session/Administration of SAT followed by B and C channel classes.
- Grade 12–No School for Students/A great day for college and career-readiness activities
