- I. Adoption of Minutes from December 2018
  - A. Motion to adopt: Michael Douglas

- II. Progress with STEM school designation – Mrs. Johnston
  - A. Received Silver Designation. Not awarded yet. 9 Schools applied across the state this year (4 schools in Davis district). Will go to the School Board for approval in April.
  - B. Committee: 38 indicators including student & school self-reflection, teacher involvement.
  - C. Plan to upgrade/apply for Platinum or Gold next year
  - D. Improves the likelihood of receiving grant money from the STEM action center
- III. Career Day update
  - A. Coordination needs with CC: Sign up Genius for sign ups

  - C. K-2: Presenters will have 20 minutes going into the class

    - i. Small group time now used for Language Arts & Math. Mrs. Johnston proposed we keep the Lang Arts & Math small groups.
    - ii. Goal for 2017-18: K-3; 81% at or above DIBELS benchmark (achieved 81.2%)
    - iii. Class size projection for 2019-2020: 25.38 SPC (27.25 students per classroom mandated by legislature)
      1. 24 in Kindergarten
      2. 18.5 in 1<sup>st</sup>
  - D. Attendance: Usually 96%+ most days
  - E. Growth concerns.
    - i. Math (Average 52.9%)– went down 1.5% &
    - ii. Went down 3.6% in Lang Arts

- iii. Lowest 25% kids (Special Ed) are double weighted currently have limited/no technology (possible goal to increase their proficiency by 2%)
- iv. 10 iPads or tablets for Special Ed proposed
- v. District has new “emotional Intelligence” App to help teachers to address supports for students with anxiety, depression, organization, executive functions, ADHD
- vi. Many Behavioral issues on the Playground.
  - 1. Considering PlayWorks or another similar program to improve Social Skills
