## **PLEASE READ Carefully**

Dear Parents of Current Troy School District "Schools of Choice" Student(s),

We are pleased to inform you that the Troy School District's Board of Education has voted to continue to operate as a Limited Schools of Choice District for the 2020-2021 school year. We will accept thirty (30) incoming Kindergarten students, one (1) 1<sup>st</sup> grade student and thirteen (13) total 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. If you have a current Schools of Choice student and a sibling in your family meets this criterion, they will be eligible to submit a "Sibling Preference Application."

PLEASE NOTE: Complete and submit the attached Sibling Preference Schools of Choice Application in person to our office (Troy School District – Administrative Building – 4400 Livernois, Troy, Michigan), between Monday, March 9 and Thursday, March 26, 2020 by 4:00 PM (faxed and emailed applications will not be accepted). NO EXCEPTIONS

After the application deadline on Thursday, March 26, 2020 there will be a determination made as to whether or not a lottery is necessary. If necessary, the lottery will take place on Thursday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>. Sibling preference students will be awarded first placement and enrollment guidelines will be sent the following week.

If your "Sibling Preference" Application/Enrollment is for Kindergarten or 1<sup>st</sup> grade placement, and you have a current Schools of Choice student that will be in Grade 1-5 for the 2020-2021 school year, your incoming Kindergarten or 1<sup>st</sup> grade student will be placed at the same elementary building as the "attending" sibling. If you do not have a Schools of Choice student attending an elementary at the time when the "Sibling Preference" will be entering, your student will be placed based on building availability. If your "Sibling Preference" Application/Enrollment is for a middle school student, these students are placed based on building availability.
