Incoming kindergarten children must turn 5 by or before September 1, 2019

Children can be with you but it is not mandatory. This is strictly a paperwork day.

Illinois Physical with all required immunizations, Illinois Dental Form, and Illinois Eye Examination Form are mandatory to begin kindergarten. These documents are required prior to the first day of school, but not needed on registration day (forms will be handed out on the 26th)
