

CogAT TESTING: Students in 2nd and 4th grades and 3rd and 5th students who are new to WW will take the CogAT assessments next week. CogAT tests are administered to measure levels and patterns of cognitive development for students. Abilities are assessed in three ways:

Verbal: Measures inductive and deductive reasoning skills and includes items such as verbal classification, sentence composition, and verbal analogies.

Quantitative: Measures quantitative relations, number series, and equation building.

Nonverbal: Presents novel problems to students using geometric shapes and figures in which students must use strategies for dealing with new material.

These assessments are used as a part of the Enrichment Eagles identification process and to determine middle school math and English placement. To learn more about the Enrichment Eagles program go to:
