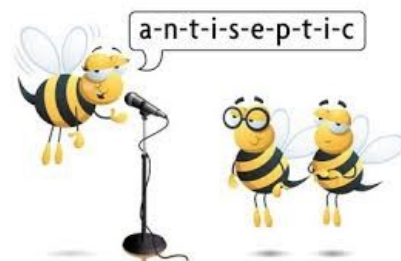

Entering this information ahead of time allows us to generate a code for you to register with on 2/26/19. In order to register your child for kindergarten for the 2019-20 school year, he/she must turn 5 years old on or before September 1st of 2019. You will need: Original certified copy of your child's birth certificate (no photocopies will be accepted), Three proofs of residency, Fees have yet to be determined, we will let you know that information as soon as we have it. All health records (dental exam, vision exam, and Illinois physical exam with immunizations) Due prior to first day of school.
