If you, or anyone you know in our district, have a 5 year old child, you will need to pre-register online through www.dunlapcusd.net/registration. The window is open until midnight on February 26th. On Tuesday you should bring 3 proofs of residency, and an **original certified** birth certificate. The registration fee of \$140.00 can be paid online or at school during the registration. Checks made payable to Dunlap School District. *Note that a fee of 3.49% will be charged if you pay by credit card online. You may also bring any health records. Prior to the first day of school, we require a current Illinois school physical form, a record of immunizations, a current dental exam, and a current eye exam.
