



## **Summer Lunch Bunch Food Service Guidelines**

The Summer Lunch Program in Shawnee Mission School District is open to any child regardless of where they live.

- Meals are free to any child between the ages of 1 and 18.
- No food/beverage from meals taken out of the dining room.
- Adults may NOT eat from a child's tray.
- Adult meals are available for \$4.25 cash only (no debit/credit or checks).

Parents and/or children must monitor any food allergies themselves. There is one hot entrée choice available each day. Yogurt with Muffin is an alternate entrée choice available daily.

Equipment such as skateboards and basketballs cannot be brought into the building. The district is not responsible for unattended or unsecured equipment left inside or outside the building.

Shirt, shoes and respect are required for service. Swimsuits must be covered appropriately.

People attending that do not behave in an appropriate manner as determined by the monitor or site manager will be asked to leave. A second incident will result in the child not being allowed to return to the meal program. As needed, the local police department may be contacted for inappropriate behavior.

The expectation is that students and adults will follow the typical school rules for behavior. Examples of unacceptable behavior include but are not limited to the following:

- Horseplay
- Running
- Rowdiness
- Profanity
- Yelling or use of loud voices
- Lack of respect for others attending the meal site or for the site staff
- Refusal to follow instructions or posted regulations about consuming of food
