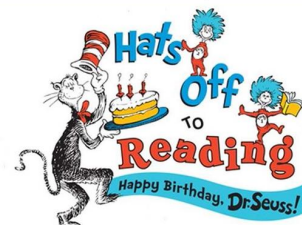
Center. The evening includes gourmet food stations, complimentary beverages, desserts and coffee, an extensive silent auction, and an exciting live auction.
